Choose the perfect spot!
The ideal place to keep your quilt? A room that has a constant temperature and humidity level and is out of direct sunlight or florescent light. And if you prefer to store your quilt in a box or rolling tube, skip the cardboard or plastic and instead choose an acid-free version (available at HollingerMetalEdge.com).

packing your quilt away, first wash and thoroughly dry your hands to remove any oils. Then wrap the quilt in acid-free tissue paper and place it alone in its box without any perfume sachets, mothballs, photographs or other mementos—they can damage the fabric over time.



you store your quilt, it's smart to take it out every few months and let it air out for a few hours. Then when you put it away, refold it in a different way so that it doesn't become permanently creased!
