4 Station Set

Station 1: Tree Craft



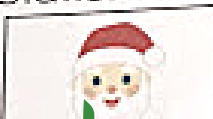
Student will trace 3 trees on green construction paper, cut them out, and then decorate the trees. Then fold the trees in half vertically and glue together so the tree stands.
Materials needed: green construction paper, scissors, glue, decorations.

Station 2: Christmas Cookies



Make sugar cookies or buy pre-bought sugar cookies. Students will decorate the cookies with frosting and sprinkles.
Materials needed: sugar cookies, frosting, sprinkles, paper plates, plastic knives, napkins, paper cups, other decorations!

Station 3: Pictionary Holiday Dabbers



Choose either Pictionary or Holiday Dabbers for each group. For Pictionary, give each student a dabber board and a dabber. For Holiday Dabbers, give each student a dabber board and a dabber. (Dabbers Game - page 10)

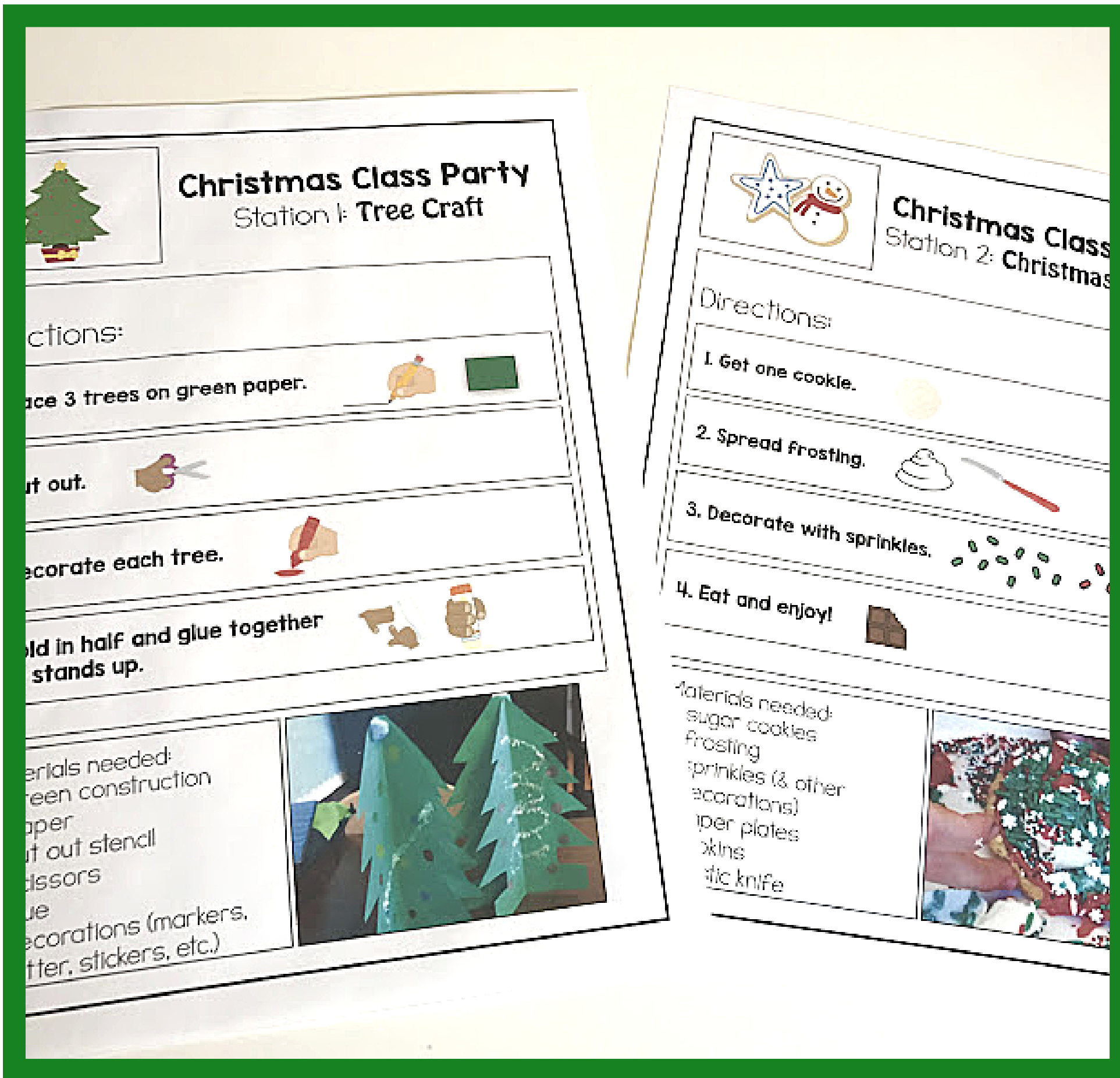

4. Find all the items. 

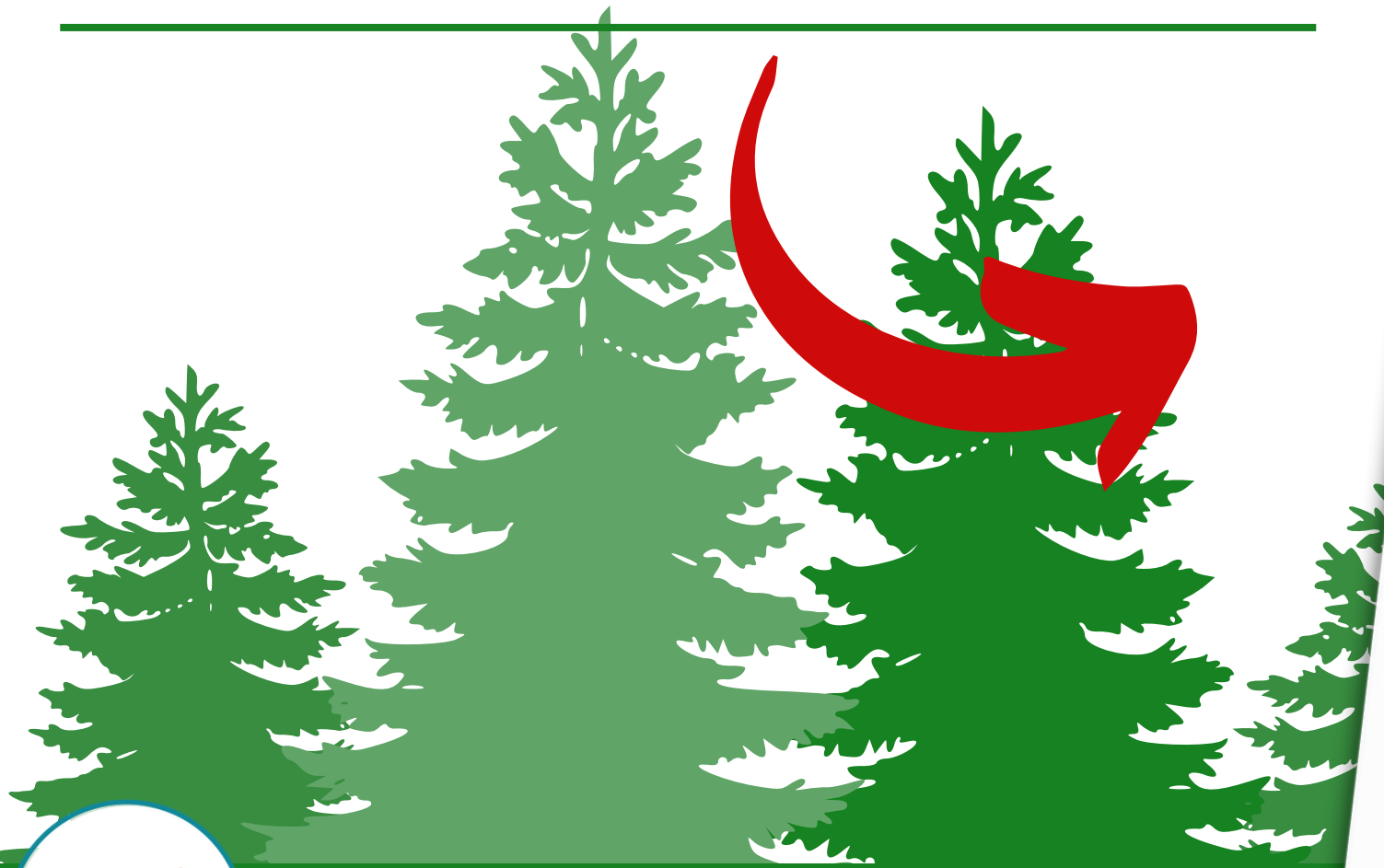

Instructions

This resource will completely organize and set up your class party! The party will consist of 5 stations. Students will be in groups and rotate between the five stations for a preset amount of time. Each station will be run by an adult (or independent if that works for your students). I recommend inviting the SLP, OT, case manager, or parent volunteers to come into your class so you can have an adult for each station. Station 3 has two game options depending on your students' level. If that works, you can have everyone complete one of the activities or switch the type of game based on the group.

Print all pages. On the Schedule & Group List page, write in the assigned adult and location for each station. Also, write in the times for each rotation. Group your class into 5 groups and list them under Group A, B, C, D, and E. Cut the student schedules into strips and write student names on the page. Let students cross off each station after they complete it.

Each station has a master direction card that includes visual directions, a list of materials needed, and sometimes a photo sample. Post the page at each station. Set up the materials as listed.

When the party begins, bring Group A to station 1, Group B to station 2, etc. When the allotted time is up, let the group know you will be switching or help each group switch individually.

Below is the shopping list for needed supplies for the party as well as common classroom materials you may already have. I hope you and your class have a great party!

Shopping List

- sugar cookies
- frosting
- sprinkles & cookie decorations
- rice filled bin (add peppermint extract for smell)
- mini candy canes
- a few small ornaments
- a few small gifts
