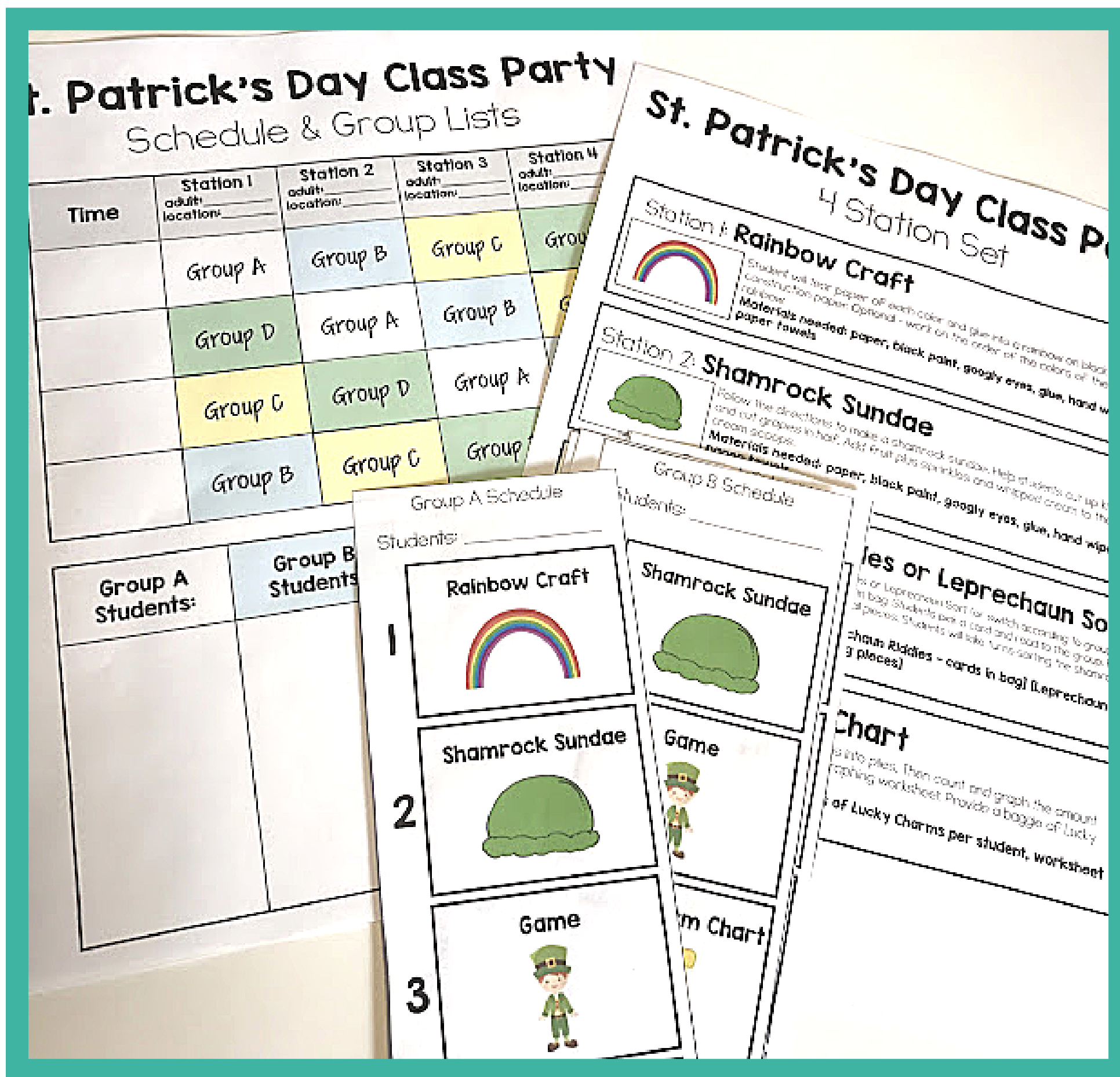

Christmas Class Party

4 Station Set

Tree Craft

Student will trace 3 trees on green construction paper, cut them out, and then decorate the trees. Then fold the trees in half vertically and glue together so the tree stands.
Materials needed: green construction paper, scissors, glue, decorations.

Christmas Cookies

Make sugar cookies or buy store bought sugar cookies. Students will decorate the cookies with frosting and sprinkles.
Materials needed: sugar cookies, sprinkles, frosting, paper plates, plastic knives, napkins, (optional: other decorations)

Pictionary or Holiday Dabbers

Choose either Holiday Pictionary or Holiday Dabbers for each number in group. For Holiday Pictionary, students will select a pictionary card and draw the item on the card while other students guess. For Holiday Dabbers, give each student a dabber board and a dabber or bingo stamper. Cut up the cards. Show each card and when you draw the card have students find the match and stamp it.
Materials needed: (Pictionary = cards in bag) (Dabbers Game = page per student and cut up calling cards)

Find It

Fill a bin with rice or pasta (add peppermint extract if using rice) and mix in the bin (add multiple of each item). Students will search and look for the corresponding item.
Materials needed: small items (candy canes, ribbon, spice drop candles)





Station 3 has two options for games depending on the level of your students. You can have everyone complete one of the activities or you can switch the type of game based on the group.

Print all pages. On the Schedule & Group List page write in the assigned adult and location for each station. Also write in the times for each rotation. Group your class into 4 groups and list them under Group A, B, C, and D. Cut the student schedules into strips and post them on the page. Let students cross off each station after they complete it.

Each station has a master direction card that includes visual directions, a list of materials needed, and sometimes a photo sample. Post the page at each station.

When the party begins, bring Group A to station 1, Group B to station 2, etc. When the allotted time is up, let the group know you will be switching or help each group switch individually.
