FIBREGLASS STAIR NOSING

INSTALLATION GUIDE

PREPARATION:

- **1.** Clean the area before installing.
- 2. Measure the stairs width and find the which Stair Nosing length is ideal for your situation. (We supply in a variety of Stair Nosing sizes & colours on our website).

If you do require to cut the stair nosings to a specific length, this can be easily done (we recommend using a diamond blade cutter).









INSTALLATION:

3a. Wooden Stairs: Pre-drill & screw into place approximately every 400mm. Use stainless steel screws outside.

Diamond Blade Cutter

- **3b.** Metal Stairs: Pre-drill & screw into place approximately every 400mm. Use stainless steel selftapping screws. Alternatively, you can use the clip & fastener system.
- **3c.** Metal Grating Stairs: Pre-drill & screw into place approximately every 400mm. Use the clip & fastener system which is used to hold the stair nosing in place on metal grating stair applications.
- **3d.** Concrete Stairs: Pre-drill & screw into place approximately every 400mm using concrete screws, or glue using Sika SuperGrip Premium Construction Adhesive or Bostik Seal n Flex.
