## Ceramics

Unless stated otherwise, all Claire Lune ceramics are made with high-fire stoneware and porcelain. The quality of these materials and the temperatures at which they are fired (+1200C) are guarantees of quality and durability. However, handmade products always require more care than industrial ones, so please beware of this when handling your items.

## Wall Art

Both originals and art prints use high quality, fine art and/or handmade paper.

All types of papers used for our wall art are produced at the highest standards of quality to ensure durability and maintain colour quality over time.





### Claire Lune Ceramic Care

- Always follow the instructions for the specific item, when indicated in the description.
- Always use mild cleaning agents.
- Never use chemical cleaning products or harsh abrasives.
- To preserve the colour of the materials, avoid prolonged direct sunlight whenever possible.
- Be mindful of placing items close to heat sources.
- Items for indoor use only should never be used outdoors.
- Clean ceramic surfaces with mild detergent such as washing up liquid. For stain removal use a gentle soap applied to a damp cotton cloth and wipe dry with a clean cloth afterwards. Do not use chemical cleaners or harsh abrasives.
- For incense burners and any other ceramic piece that will be used for smoke rituals, please be aware that heat and fire can damage both glazed and unglazed surfaces. Do not use incense cones, resins or other burning agents directly on the pieces, unless stated otherwise in the description. Minor smoke stains may be removable with a damp cloth.

- Given the handmade nature of our products, materials may display slight colour/surface variations.
- Artistic vases, with a glaze interior and an unglazed base or exterior surface may transfer humidity onto porous surfaces of furniture, if filled with water. Please, always test before using and/or use a cloth between the base of the vase and the furniture surface that you would like to preserve.
- For any functional piece, such as plates, cups etc., avoid thermal shock, which may cause the piece to break. I highly discourage using handmade ceramics in the oven or the freezer. Do not place a plate from the fridge directly into the oven and vice versa.
- Our functional ceramics can be washed in the dishwasher, although I highly recommend hand washing as it is more gentle on the glazes and surfaces of the pieces.

### Claire Lune Wall Art Care

- Do not bend or fold the paper.
- Avoid hanging your painting in direct sunlight or too close to heat sources (fire place, stoves, etc.)
