HISTORICAL INHERITANCE

The history of the Persian culture dates back to thousands of years of innovation. Persian kings and dynasties were responsible for these (and many other) groundbreaking innovations:

- First to use fire for making implements and weapons
- First to use iron for tools and utensils
- Introduction of writing and weaving
- Unearthing of gold and silver for ornaments
- Making of wine from sugar cane
- Construction of roads
- · Building of ships
- Use of irrigation
- Humanitarian work
- Poetry, (many of these leaders in Persian poetry are still honored today)
- Creation of first postal service (leading to the pony express)



At KS Movement we see this precedent toward innovation as an important key to unlocking the inheritance of salvation for Iranians. Not only are the Iranian people destined to have the One true God as the Lord of their land, but they are destined to use their creative ingenuity to spread His name throughout the Middle East!

Historically, Persians were instrumental in the salvation of other nations. We believe history will repeat itself as these young Christians move out from Iran, bringing the fire of the gospel throughout their neighboring regions. In our modern times, closed governmental systems and false ideology has stolen this identity and inheritance of the Iranians. It only took 40 years for the Iranian regime to strip their people of thousands of years of innovation and cultural identity.

When you transform a nation with the love of Christ, you restore their identity to better than it was before! Through people like you and me, Jesus restores the heart of these nations and reclaims their cultural identity as innovators and fiery messengers of the gospel.



BIBLICAL SIGNIFICANCE

We start with 3 Persian kings in the Bible: Cyrus, Darius and Artaxerxes.

Cyrus the great (Benevolent Conqueror) was the first humanitarian. He conquered almost every culture in his time (millions of people), yet he allowed them to continue their own style of worship as they wished—as long as they got along with each other. For this reason, he allowed the Jewish nation to be restored and valued. Honor besets honor! Here we see the connection to the Iranian Christian youth's inheritance of bringing salvation to other nations.

Darius followed in Cyrus' footsteps, and next the
Persian King Artaxerxes married a beautiful Jewess,
Esther, who was instrumental in compelling her
husband to save her people from extinction. Persians
are called to preserve the identity of other nations.






PRESENT-DAY CHURCH GROWTH
