# LED MODE SELECTION OVERVIEW

Press 🔅 button to cycle through different LED modes. Hold 🔆 button to turn off top and bottom light. Hold 🔅 button to turn off center light. Double press 🔅 button to turn on/off side flashing lights.

- If you want to unpair them, press the 🔀 to disconnect.
  - The speaker will beep and both LEDs will flash indicating the speakers are no longer paired.



### TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Solution	
No power	<ul> <li>Make sure your speaker is turned on and make sure your speaker is completely charged.</li> </ul>	
No sound	<ul> <li>Make sure the volume of your speaker is not at the lowest setting.</li> <li>Make sure the connected audio device is playing audio.</li> </ul>	
Sound is distorted	<ul> <li>Turn down the volume of the speaker or the connected device.</li> </ul>	
Cannot pair with my play device	<ul> <li>Make sure wireless mode on your device is turned on.</li> <li>Your wireless device may be out of range. Try moving it closer to the speaker.</li> <li>Move your wireless device and/or speaker away from other devices that generate electromagnetic interference, such as phones, microwave ovens, wireless netwo routers, or other wireless devices.</li> </ul>	

# **BATTERY HEALTH**

To prevent the possibility of the battery from leaking, heating or catching fire, please follow these precautions:

- Please disconnect charge cable after speaker is fully charged.
- Do not continue to charge speaker after it is fully charged.
