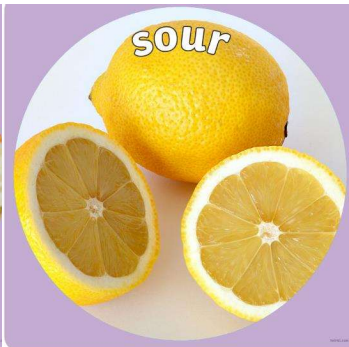
word banks to support descriptive language

- We have also attached a mind map where children can brainstorm, imagine, and create a new ball using their senses. They can write the words and describe it.

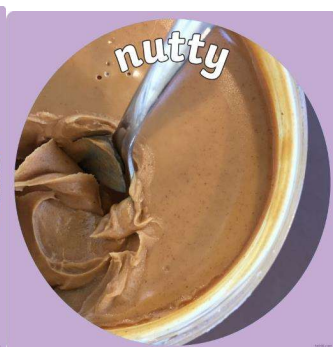


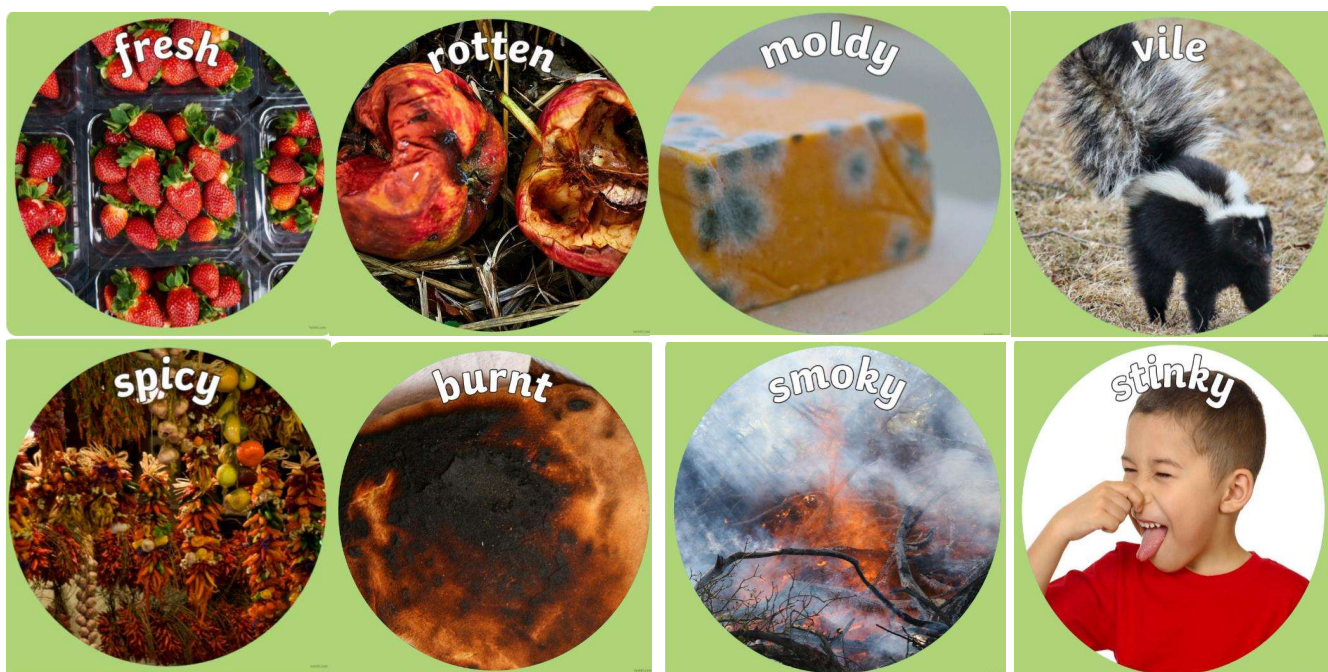
Texture- what does it feel like ?
