Background

Evidence shows TCM has potential as safe and effective therapy for food allergy and eczema. Triple TCM Therapy including ingestion, bath, and cream markedly improved severe skin lesion, itching, sleep loss in patients with corticosteroid dependent, recalcitrant, or topical steroid withdrawal syndrome.

DR. LAN IS RECOGNIZED AS THE MOST PRESTIGIOUS TCM DIABETES EXPERT

- **Chief researcher, chief physician, doctoral supervisor, post-doctoral supervisor** of China Academy of Chinese Medical Sciences
- **Honorary president**, Endocrinology Branch of China Traditional Chinese Medicine Information Society
- **Presided** over more than 10 national research projects, the National Natural Science Foundation of China, and the National Administration of Traditional Chinese Medicine
- **Founded** the theory of "three types of syndrome differentiation" of diabetes, which was included in the national "Guiding Principles of Clinical Research on New Chinese Medicines," leading the medical treatment, scientific research, and new drug development in the field of diabetes
- **For the first time in China**, Dr. Lan advocated "replenishing qi and nourishing yin" as the basic principle for the prevention and treatment of diabetes," and developed the first Chinese medicine hypoglycemic preparation in China which has obtained 4 new drug certificates and 4 national patents and 16 prizes

Background

Professor Lin Lan conducted a systematic macroscopic syndrome differentiation of traditional Chinese medicine on 635 diabetic patients. Dr. Lan believes that diabetic patients are divided into three syndromes: yin deficiency and heat excess, qi and yin deficiency, and yin and yang deficiency, with a commonality of yin deficiency.

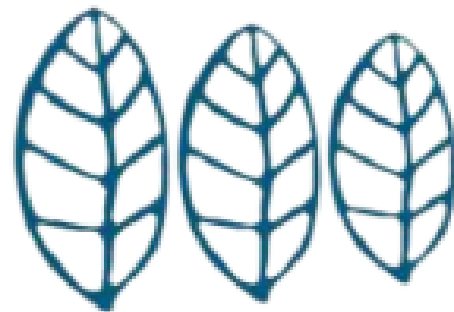

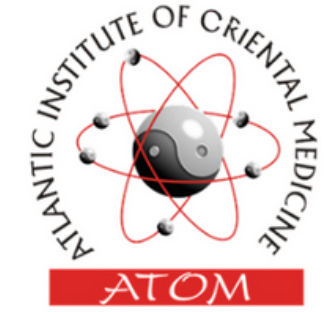

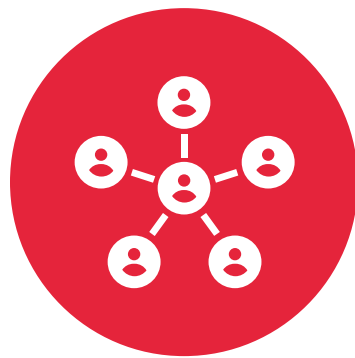
