- Chief researcher, chief physician, doctoral supervisor, post-doctoral supervisor of China Academy of Chinese Medical Sciences
- Honorary president, Endocrinology Branch of China Traditional Chinese Medicine Information Society

Professor Lin Lan conducted a systematic 30 min macroscopic syndrome differentiation of traditional Chinese medicine on 635 diabetic patients. Dr. Lan believes that diabetic patients are divided into three 30 min syndromes: yin deficiency and heat excess, qi and yin deficiency, and yin and yang deficiency, with a commonality of yin 30 min deficiency.


