

Session 3: TCM treatment principles & methods of treatment for infertility (120 min with Q&A) Mar 8 In this session, Dr. Wang will introduce TCM treatment methods for infertility, including herbal formulas and acupuncture.

Session 4: The Four-Step treatment approach of Prof. Zhiqiang Guo (120 min with Q&A) Apr 12 In this session, Prof Guo Zhiqiang's experience in the treatment of infertility will be introduced in detail.

Dr. Tan's research contributions in female reproductive endocrine disorders include:

Dr. Tan has conducted research on menopausal syndrome with Yin deficiency type and on the effect of tonifying the kidney and regulating the cycle on assisted reproductive technology.

In recent years, Dr. Tan inherited and carried out the research of the famous Chinese doctor, Xia Guicheng, on the effect of tonifying the kidney on polycystic ovary syndrome, endometriosis, and corpus luteum insufficiency.

### Comprehensive Application of Chinese Medicine and Assisted Reproductive Medicine (1 class)

#### Abstract:

Since the birth of the first test-tube baby in 1978, assistive reproductive technique (ART) has become more widely used and blessed countless infertility patients. Due to controlled ovulation induction, invitro fertilization (IVF) and embryo culture procedures are still far from standard requirements, and how to improve the success rate of artificial assisted pregnancy technology is a common concern for patients and professionals.

By combining the advantages of Chinese and Western medicine, comprehensive application of Chinese medicine and ART has become much more developed in the medical field.
