- Dr. Wang is a renowned Chinese gynecologist, chief physician, professor, and supervisor to graduate students at the Dongzhimen Hospital of Beijing University of Traditional Chinese Medicine.
- Dr. Wang won the People's Doctor Award in 2016 in China and was a visiting scholar at Massachusetts Medical School in the United States.
- Dr. Wang studied under the famous TCM gynecologist Prof. Guo Zhiqiang, and serves as Executive Vice President of Guo Zhiqiang's Academic Research Association of the Beijing Royal Medical Research Association.
- Dr. Wang is a former member of the Chinese Gynecology Academic Committee, Executive Director of the Gutuo Therapy Professional Committee of the World Federation of TCM, Vice President of Gynecology Branch of Integrated Traditional Chinese and Western Medicine of China Folk Traditional Chinese Medicine Research and Development Association.
- Dr. Wang has published 12 professional books and more than 20 papers during over 40 years of clinical, teaching, and scientific research work in gynecology.
- Dr Wang has helped over 100,000 women become pregnant.

Session 2: Introduction of Infertility in TCM (120 min with Q & A) Feb 15

Dr. Wang will be addressing the basic concept of infertility in both its Western and Chinese Medicine contexts, as well as the recognition of the disease and the evolution of its name in the history of Traditional Chinese Medicine.

Session 3: TCM treatment principles & methods of treatment for infertility (120 min with Q&A) Mar 8

In this session, Dr. Wang will introduce TCM treatment methods for infertility, including herbal formulas and acupuncture.

Session 4: The Four-Step treatment approach of Prof. Zhiqiang Guo (120 min with Q&A) Apr 12

In this session, Prof Guo Zhiqiang's experience in the treatment of infertility will be introduced in detail.

Session 5: Clinical cases and discussion (120 min with Q&A) May 10

In this session, Prof. Guo and Dr. Wang's experience in TCM treatments on various diseases that causes infertility will be introduced in detail, including polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS), endometriosis (EMT), hyperprolactinemia (HPRL), premature ovarian failure (POF), luteal phase defect (LPD), and more. Several cases will be presented for further discussion.

Dr. Yong Tan holds the following positions:

- Vice Chairman of the Society of Reproductive Medicine;
- Vice Chairman of the Gynecology Branch of the World Federation of Chinese Medicine; and
- Standing Committee Member of the Obstetrics, and Gynecology Committee of the Nanjing Medical Association.

Dr. Tan has a doctorate in medicine from the National Asahikawa Medical University in Japan

Contributions

Dr. Tan Yong's Research Contributions & Accomplishments

Dr. Tan's research contributions in female reproductive endocrine disorders include:

- motility menstrual disorders
- polycystic ovary syndrome
- infertility, and
- menopausal syndrome

Dr. Tan has conducted research on menopausal syndrome with Yin deficiency type and on the effect of tonifying the kidney and regulating the cycle on assisted reproductive technology.

In recent years, Dr. Tan inherited and carried out the research of the famous Chinese doctor, Xia Guicheng, on the effect of tonifying the kidney on polycystic ovary syndrome, endometriosis, and corpus luteum insufficiency.

- Dr. Tan has presided over six scientific research projects at, or above, the provincial level and has engaged in clinical gynecology education for more than 20 years.
- For her work, she was awarded the second prize of Jiangsu Science and Technology Progress Award and the second prize of Nanjing Urban Women's Science and Technology Invention Award.
- Dr. Tan has participated in the five- and seven-year programs of "Chinese Medicine Gynecology" hosted by the Ministry of Health and the Administration of Traditional Chinese Medicine.
- Dr. Tan has contributed to numerous medical texts including "Integrated Traditional Chinese and Western Medicine Obstetrics and Gynecology", "Gynecology and Obstetrics Nursing", and the bilingual compilation "Chinese Medicine Gynecology".
- Dr. Tan has trained more than 20 doctoral and masters graduate students and published more than 30 papers and monographs.

Comprehensive Application of Chinese Medicine and Assisted Reproductive Medicine (1 class)

Abstract:

Since the birth of the first test-tube baby in 1978, assistive reproductive technique (ART) has become more widely used and blessed countless infertility patients. Due to controlled ovulation induction, in-vitro fertilization (IVF) and embryo culture procedures are still far from standard requirements, and how to improve the success rate of artificial assisted pregnancy technology is a common concern for patients and professionals.

By combining the advantages of Chinese and Western medicine, comprehensive application of Chinese medicine and ART has become much more developed in the medical field.
