POTTERY – HAND BUILDING

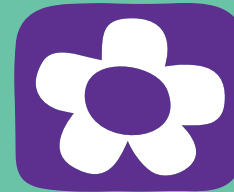

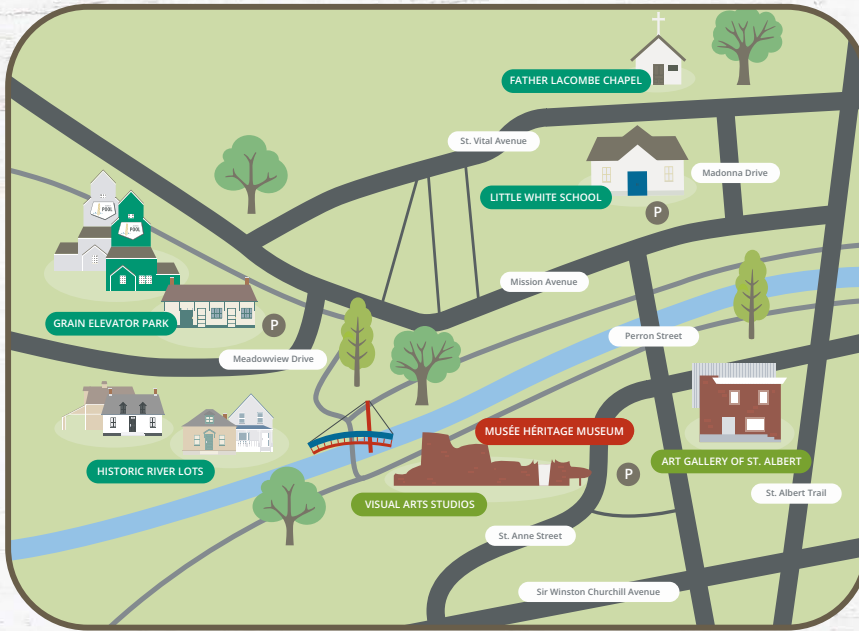
