WHY THE BAN?

Plastic bags are common pollution that end up in our trees, streets, parks, and rivers. Banning the use of plastic bags will decrease litter, prevent storm drain blockages, and contribute to a healthier Salisbury.

WHO IS AFFECTED?

All supermarkets, convenience stores, and other sales outlets within City limits are prohibited from providing customers with single-use plastic bags at point of sale.
