

Model CA-90 Bathroom Ductless Fan Motor Mount Assembly Specifications

Thank you for keeping your CA -90 Ductless Fan in good working condition.

Motor mount assembly consists of:

- 1. Motor
- 2. Fan blade
- 3. Motor mount
- 4. Male plug



Inside the Ductless Fan

Complete Unit consists of:

- A. Motor Mount Assembly (motor, fan blade, motor mount and male plug)
- B. Louver 5-5/8" X 11 15/16" X 3/4"
- C. Cartridge Filter 3" X 3"
- D. Metal Housing 4" X 3 7/16" X 10"
- E. Cover plate
- F. Receptacle
- G. 2 Large Screws and 2 small screws.

On the picture to the right, you are able to see inside the complete unit. This demonstrates the fan assembly installed. The 2 small screws are the only attachment required for installation to the housing. The top of the motor mount sits level with the metal housing can.


INSTRUCTIONS & SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Housing Dimension: 4'X3 7/16"X 10" (see drawing)
- 2. Packaging: Bulk packed, 12 units to a carton or single pack
 - Pack "A" includes housing, female plug instructions. Pack "B" includes grill, filter, motor assembly & 2 screws
- 3. Voltage: Unit operates on standard 120 volt house currant.
- 4. Motor: 1/250 HP, 2800 RPM, 23 watts, 0285 amps.
- 5. Unit is UL listed.
- Grill: Attached by a single screw in each end. Made of high-impact plastic. Available in beige and white. 5 5/8" X 11 15/16" X 3/4 " (see drawing)

FILTER REPLACEMENT

The unit contains one replaceable CA-90 filter casing made of high-impact plastic. The CA-90 Deodorizer filter is easily replaced without removing the grill (see drawing). For best results the CA-90 filter should be replaced every six months or more frequently as needed.

MAINTENANCE

Easy to care for; just wipe the grill face with a damp cloth. To clean the inside of the unit, remove the screws in thegrill face, remove the grill from the housing, and unplug the fan motor before cleaning. Use a soft brush (such as alonghandled paint brush) to clean the motor and motor housing. or use a vacuum cleaner to remove dust and debris from the interior of the unit. Do not use harsh detergents. Unplug the Fan motor before cleaning.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Unit is intended for ceiling mount
- 2. If wallboard is installed before "rough-in", see unit dimensions (on the front page) for opening size.
- 3. Unit can be attached directly to joists.
- 4. Wiring: 120 volt. Plug –in fan for easy hookup
