



Drying Instructions

Microwave

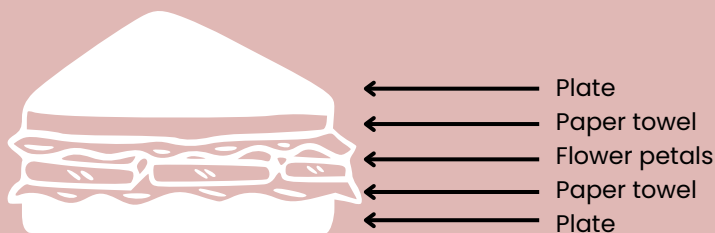
The following drying instructions are for petals only, not whole flowers

Drying Instructions Video

You will need:

- Paper towel
- Microwave
- 2 ceramic plates

- 1 Place a piece of paper towel on a ceramic plate
- 2 Gentle pull off the petals from the flower head and place them on the paper towel. Make sure they are not overlapping or they will stick together
- 3 Place another piece of paper towel on the top
- 4 Gently sit another plate on top.
You should have a "sandwich" like so:



- 5 Put the "sandwich" in the microwave for 30 seconds.
- 6 Check the petals by removing the top plate and lifting up the paper towel. They most likely won't be dry yet so put the paper towel back on the top (replace it with a fresh sheet if it's too wet) but leave the top plate off (it's only there originally to keep them flat) and microwave for another 15 seconds.
- 7 Check the petals again and continue doing 15 second intervals until the petals are completely dry. You'll know when they're dry when they turn crunchy like a potato chip. Some petals could dry faster than other petals, if this happens, just remove the dry ones and continue heating the others until they're dry. If you overheat them they will burn
