## VINEYARD

Grape Varieties: 100% Garnacha  
Vins Age: 75 years average, older vins planted since 1903  
Elevation: 1,300 to 2,000 ft  
Soil: Clay and calcareous soils, with boulders on surface  
Climate: Atlantic Continental  
Harvest: By hand, on small cases (12Kg)

## WINEMAKING

Winemaker: Enrique Basarte and Elisa Úcar  
Fermentation: On controlled temperature stainless steel vats  
Maturation: 14 months in French oak barrels (500, 300 and 225 liter)

## WINE

Alcohol: 13.5%  
Production: 2,200 cases

## PITCH

- Small production
- Old vines. Over 115 years, with variety of biotypes of black Grenache grape in each of the plots
- Micro-plot, from 12 different plots located in diverse zones. The biggest one has 1.7 acres
- 100% own vineyards
- Mountain Viticulture
- Traditional, respectful growing with the environment “reasoned viticulture”

## TASTE

It is a deeply colored wine with a crystal clear purity of fruit rarely found in Grenache-based wines. Aromatically complex with layers of floral, cherry, and spice, a sip is superbly balanced and practically begs another in short measure.
