## VINEYARD

Grape Varieties: 100% Garnacha

Vins Age: 75 years average, older vins planted since 1903

Elevation: 2,000 to 2,500 ft

Soil: Clay-calcareous structure

Climate: Atlantic Continental

Harvest: By hand, on small cases (12Kg)

## WINEMAKING

Winemaker: Enrique Basarte and Elisa Úcar

Fermentation: On controlled temperature stainless steel vats (3,500 liter)

Maturation: 14 months on French oak barrels (700, 500 and 300 liter)

## WINE

Alcohol: 14%

Production: Less than 600 cases

## PITCH

- Minuscule production
- 100% own vineyards
- Mountain Viticulture
- Old vines. Vins planted since 1903, with variety of biotypes of black Grenache grape in each of the plots
- Micro-plot, from 15 different plots located in diverse zones. The biggest one has 1.2 acres
- Clay-calcareous structure with appearance of “mother-rock” which gives wine minerality
- Traditional, respectful growing with the environment “reasoned viticulture”
- This is quite possibly the finest Grenache-based wine in all of Spain and suitable for long-term cellar development

## TASTE

Expressive mineral, floral, spice box, and black cherry aromas lead to a wine with terrific intensity and concentration contained within its elegant personality. It is built for the long haul with a drinking window that will extend from 2016 to 2033 (Robert Parker)
