



Instructions: Applique For Various Designs

1. Gather materials

- Embroidery vinyl, felt or nylon for applique material
- Masking tape
- Tear away stabilizer suggested, for larger designs a stiffer stabilizer is recommended

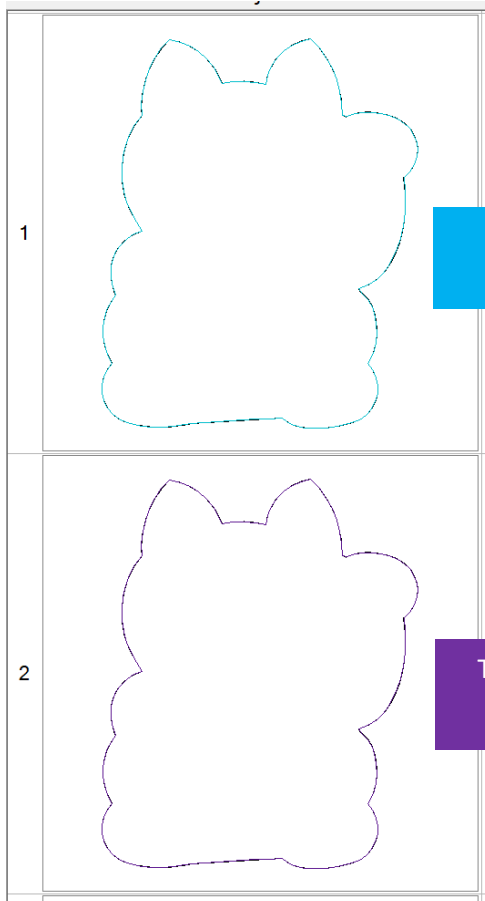
2. Cut out material pieces

- Material pieces should be large enough to cover the design with some extra fabric that will be trimmed away at the end, will be held in place with tape

3. Load embroidery design. Set up appropriate hoop for design size.

An applique generally has the following steps in all MochiMakes designs:

- Run placement stitch (typically in TEAL)
- Place applique fabric down
- Run tack down stitch (typically in PURPLE)
- Trim excess applique fabric, trimming as close to the tack down stitch as possible
- Run remainder detail stitches specific to the design
- Run satin stitch that covers raw edge of applique

fabric

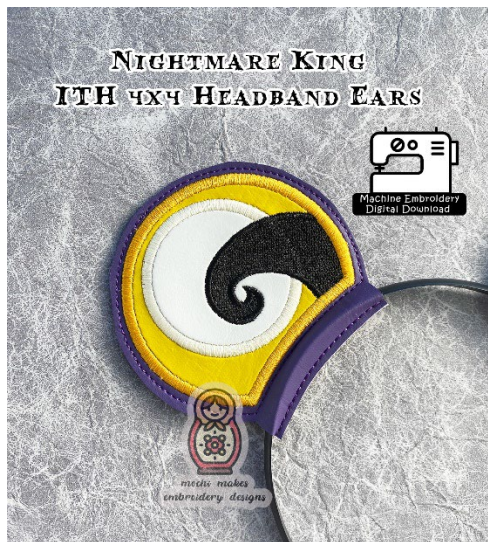


The **placement stitch** and **tack down stitch** will almost always appear **back to back** in the thread colour sequence.

Color Sequence:

#	Color	Element
1.	12	Placement Stitch to cover with applique fabric
2.	7	Tack Down Stitch to hold down fabric
3.	4	
4.	10	
5.	4	

4. There may be MULTIPLE applique components in a design. In the pattern print out you will see them listed in coordinating colours for the placement stitch, tack down stitch, and finishing satin stitch.
