

Features:

The ADR allows you to simulate the dice rolls of **D2**, **D4**, **D6**, **D8**, **D10**, **D12**, **D20** and **D100**. It also automatically sums the results of dice rolls together and can roll with advantage and disadvantage (rolling two dice and taking the highest or lowest result respectively).

Additional features include adding or subtracting by 1 for modifiers to rolls and being able to split rolls into 2 separate types and see a full total. The Total screen also shows the average D20 roll in a session, so you can see how well you have been rolling.

Operation:

- To start using the device press the button that represents the dice you want to roll. The display will immediately show the result of the random number in the roll section, and the dice number in the bottom right will increase.
- You can then press another dice button and the roll in the bottom left will change to the new result as well as the new sum in the top left.
- The up and down arrows can be used to adjust the roll modifier by adding or subtracting one. These can be pressed multiple times in succession to modify by a value more than one.
- The Clear button has two functions. If pressed once quickly it will disregard the last roll and remove it from all totals, this can be pressed multiple times until the total is 0. The button can also be held and released for a short time to clear all rolls and totals.
- The ADV DIS button can be pressed once to reach advantage mode, twice to reach disadvantage mode and a final time to return to the standard mode. Rolling while in the ADV or DIS mode will mean the next dice is rolled twice and the highest or lowest roll is taken.
- The toggle switch lets you flick between two states and a total. This allows you to split rolls in to sub totals and the total state lets you see the grand total. This can be useful quickly swapping between two different sets of dice rolls and being able to conveniently see the total of the sets separately. This can be used for dealing with attacks that have two different damage types for example.

Please Note:

The Critical Machine Automatic Dice Roller is not a toy and has not been designed or tested to be shock or water resistant. The device may be damaged if dropped or brought into contact with liquids. The device is made by hand and so each device may vary in appearance.
