Baby Jogger Car Seat Adaptor Safety Information

As we are committed to manufacturing products that meet the highest standards of quality and safety, Baby Jogger, in cooperation with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, is voluntarily issuing a safety recall of the Car Seat Adaptor.

Q: Why is Baby Jogger conducting a recall?

A: We are conducting this recall because the car seat adaptor support bars can fail, posing a fall hazard to children.

Q: What is the date range of affected product?

A: Only car seat adaptors manufactured between April 2012 and September 2012 are affected by this product recall. The affected model numbers include:

Q: Where can I find the model number or manufactured date?

A: The model number is located on the lower right hand corner of the original package. The manufacturing date can be found on a sticker located on the bottom portion of the package.





Q: I don't have the original packaging? Can I look at the product to tell if it's part of the recall?

A: Yes. Locate the two black, metal support bars. The A support bar is the larger of the two U-shaped bars and has a red plastic tip with 10 holes. Recalled adaptors have 10 open holes in the bottom of the red portion while newer models have only four open holes and are not being recalled.



A: We have determined that the red plastic connector pieces can crack.

Q: My support bars are silver and not black? Are they part of the recall?

A: No. Prior to June 2012 we manufactured a car seat adaptor that used silver supports bars. These bars are not part of the recall.
