




## Instructions for Dactek Color Set

Congratulations on purchasing your „Dactek Color Set“. Please read these instructions carefully before you start creating your „works of art with hands and feet“!

### Content

## ... you have an everlasting memory

The Identifier system is easy to use:

1. Lightly wipe the foot or finger with the Identifier towelette
2. Gently bring the foot/hand into the correct position and then quickly remove it
3. The print will develop in 10 to 15 minutes

### Before you begin

Place the card to be printed on a non-slip surface.

### Starting...

1. Remove the wipe from the packet and wipe the baby's foot or hand with the towelette, please ensure you have completely covered the area that you will be taking a print of.
2. Please be careful not to get your fingerprints on the paper as it will spoil the sheet (your fingerprints will develop the same as the baby foot/hand!) One way around this is to have someone wipe the foot/hand with the wipe and the other person takes the print on the paper so they don't touch the wipe at all. Alternatively you could wear gloves while wiping the hand/foot and then remove these when taking the print and holding the paper.
3. Press the wiped foot/hand onto the paper, press onto the side of the paper which is NOT marked with our stamp/mark. It is recommended that you put the paper against a board of some sort – i.e. a placemat to ensure it is supported and you have something to press the hand of foot against. You could even secure it with a little clip or blue tack to keep it secure. Make sure the foot/Hand does not move when on the paper as it may result in a smudged finish. It is recommended that you press the heel onto the paper first and then roll the foot towards the toes – this way you will reach all parts of the foot. This process is always easier when the baby is relaxed or sleepy (asleep is even easier!)
4. Take the foot/hand away from the paper and you are finished! Your print will develop and you will start to see the detail magically appear.

## Important notes

**The Dactek Color Set is not a toy!**

**It is not suitable for children under 14 years of age to play with.**

Even though this is non-toxic and is used in hospitals on new-born babies please wipe the baby's hand or foot with a wet wipe (or warm soapy water) when finished to remove traces of the wipe's solution.

Please ensure that the baby does not put their hand in their mouth while it has the magic solution on the skin. This is just a recommended precaution although we have not heard of any instances where it can harm your baby.

After removing the wipes from the packaging, they must be used immediately. Put the wipes back in their original packaging and seal them in the enclosed bag, as the wipes are not durable for long after opening.

## Information on the packaging

**Contains:** crepe paper, diethyl phthalate, alkyl benzoate, fluorine

**Safety advice:** Do not put in your mouth. Avoid eye contact. Wash skin thoroughly with soapy water. Store in a cool place.

**First aid:** Avoid eye contact. This may cause slight eye irritation. Rinse eyes immediately with plenty of water. Consult a doctor.

**Skin contact:** Wash skin with soap and water. Prolonged or repeated contact may cause slight skin irritation. Stop use if irritation persists.

**If swallowed:** Drink two glasses of water and consult a doctor.
