## Barn Door Quilt

Finished Small Quilt Size: 51 1/2" x 51 11/2"


Unfinished Barn Door Quilt Block Size: 11" x 11"
Finished Barn Door Quilt Block Size: $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Quilt Cutting Instructions

## Small Quilt

Cut 1 roll of $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips ( 42 pieces)
Cut each strip into $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ (you will get 5 pieces from each strip) to make a total of 210 pieces

## Sewing Instructions for Small Barn Door Quilt Size

Note: This is a scrappy quilt, so randomly sew your strips together, when making the Strip Block. Make sure you are using contrast with color, when sewing strips together. I like to create piles of like colors, for example, the pinks in one pile, yellow in one pile, etc. As you are sewing pull a strip from each color pile. This will help you keep organized as you sew your Strip Block.

1. Sew 4 pieces $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ with right sides together to make 1 Strip Block. Make 50 Strip Blocks. Note: these can be done quickly by randomly matching the strips and sewing one after the other.
2. Press seams in each Strip Block to one side. Be careful not to distort block shape when pressing.
3. Place one Strip Block horizontally and place the other Strip Block vertically, with right sides together. Secure each corner with a pin. Match edges of the block when sewing.

4. Sew $1 / 4$ " seam around all four sides.

5. Cut Block diagonally $2 x$. Press each section. You will have 4 sections. These sections will measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Note: I do not square anything up. There is so much give and pull because the strips end up on the bias and are very forgiving when you sew them together. This allows you to match your seams.

6. With right sides together sew the 4 sections. Match seams. Make 25 Farm Door Blocks.

7. Sew 5 Farm Door Blocks together.
8. Make 5 Rows.
9. Sew Rows together to complete Farm Door Quilt.
10. Enjoy the journey!

## Medium Quilt

Cut 2 rolls of $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips ( 84 pieces)
Cut each strip into $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ (you will get 5 pieces from each strip) to make a total of 420 pieces

## Sewing Instructions for Medium Barn Door Quilt Size

Finished Medium Quilt Size: $731 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 731 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
See note under small Barn Door Quilt sewing instructions before beginning.

1. Follow instructions for the Small Quilt Size \#1-5.
2. With right sides together sew the 4 sections. Match seams. Make 50 Farm Door Blocks.
3. Sew 7 Farm Door Blocks together.
4. Make 7 Rows.
5. Sew Rows together to complete Farm Door Quilt.
6. You will have 1 extra block. This will make a perfect label for the quilt back.
7. Enjoy the journey!
