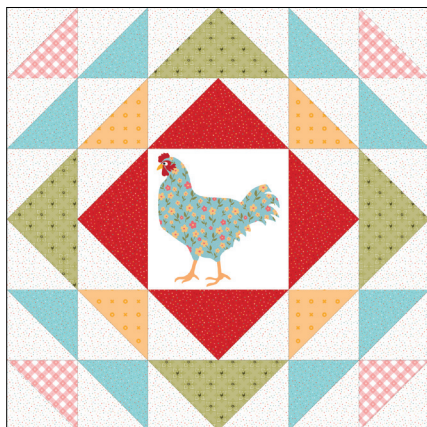


Cheeky Chicken Pillow

21" x 21"



Requirements

- 1 cheeky chicken patch
- 5 assorted fat eighths
- 1/2 yard background
- 22" square of batting
- 1/3 yard backing
- 1/4 yard binding

Cutting Instructions

From red cut:

- (4) 4" x 7 1/2"

From green cut:

- (4) 4" x 7 1/2"

*From yellow cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" squares,

*From blue cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" squares

*From pink cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" squares

**Cut yellow, blue, and pink squares in half diagonally.*

From white cut:

- (8) 4 1/2" squares, *cut in half diagonally.*
- (16) 4" squares

From backing cut:

- (2) 21 1/2" x 15 1/2"

From binding cut:

- (3) 2 1/4" strips

Seams are 1/4" and pressed open.

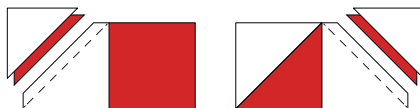
Stitch & Flip Technique

- Draw diagonal line on wrong side of top square. Place top square onto adjoining fabric RST, aligning edges. Stitch on line.
- Trim corner, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Fold top square over. Press open.



Assembly Instructions

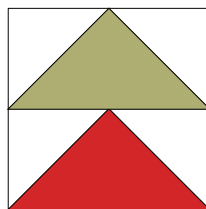
- Using Stitch & Flip, add (2) 4" squares to each rectangle. Make 2 sets of 4 flying geese for a total of 8.

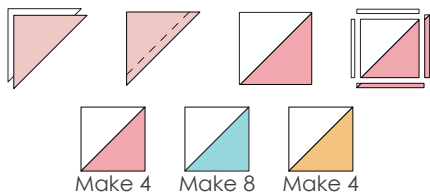

- Join 1 red and 1 green flying geese unit as shown. Make 4 units.

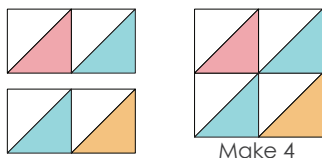

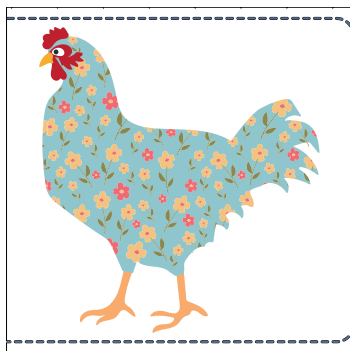
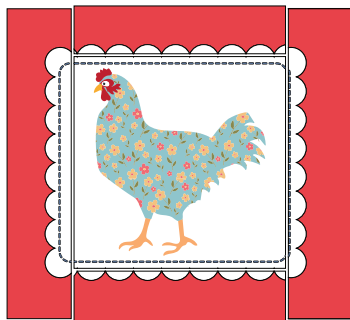
3. Lay a print and a white triangle RST. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " along the diagonal line. Press open. Trim to 4" x 4". Make 16.



4. Join 1 pink, 2 blue, and 1 yellow HST as shown. Make 4 units.

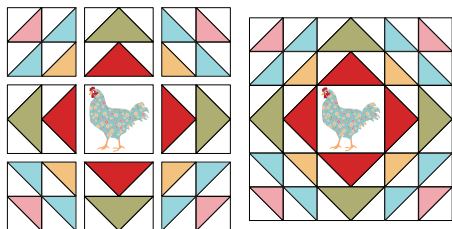


5. Trim chicken patch to $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " as shown, centering the bird.



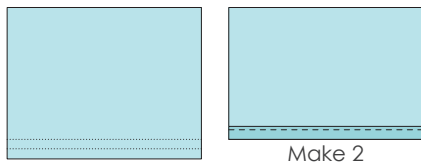
$7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ "

6. Sew the chicken, flying geese, and HSTs units together as shown.

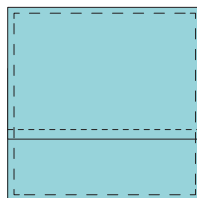
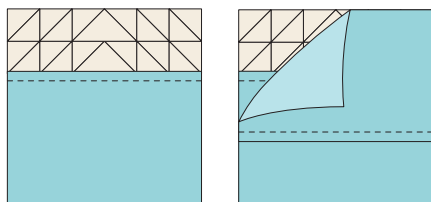


7. Layer the patchwork pillow onto the batting and quilt as desired. Trim to $21\frac{1}{2}$ " x $21\frac{1}{2}$ ".

8. Fold one long edge of a backing rectangle $\frac{1}{2}$ " twice to the wrong side. Sew the double-fold in place to hem the edge. Make 2.



9. Lay both back pieces, right sides up, onto wrong side of patchwork. Pin and baste around the edges with a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.



10. Bind the edges like a quilt. Insert a 22" pillow form.
