Quilt size: 68½" x 79½"

Block size: 9" x 9"

Cutting Instructions

Applique Blocks

Use your preferred applique method to cut out the fabric shapes with templates (keep or subtract seam allowance).

From 17 FQs (reds and pinks) cut:

- (21) large flower templates
- (21) small flower templates
- (21) center templates

From 5 FQs (green) cut:

- (63) leaf templates

From background cut:

- (6) 10½" x WOF strips, cut into (21) 10½" squares

Strawberry Blocks

From 17 FQs (reds and pinks) cut 21 sets of:

- (2) 8" x 1¼" [a]
- (2) 1¾" x 3" [e]
- (2) 3¾" x 2½" [b]
- (1) 2" square [f]
- (2) 3¾" x 2¼" [c]
- (2) 1¼" squares [g]
- (2) 2½" squares [d]
- (2) 1" squares [h]

From 5 green FQs cut 21 sets of:

- (3) 2" squares [i]
- (4) 1¾" squares [j]

From brown cut:

- (1) 1¼" x 2½" [k]

From background cut:

- (4) 3½" x WOF strips, cut into (42) 3½" squares [l]
- (4) 3" x WOF strips, cut into (42) 3" x 3⅞" [m]
- (4) 1½" x WOF strips, cut into (42) 1½" x 2" [n], (42) 1½" squares [o]
- (9) 1¼" x WOF strips, cut into (42) 1¼" x 7½" [p] and (42) 1¼" squares [q]
- (8) 1" x WOF strips, cut into (21) 1" x 8" [r], (21) 1" x 1¼" [s] and (84) 1" squares [t]

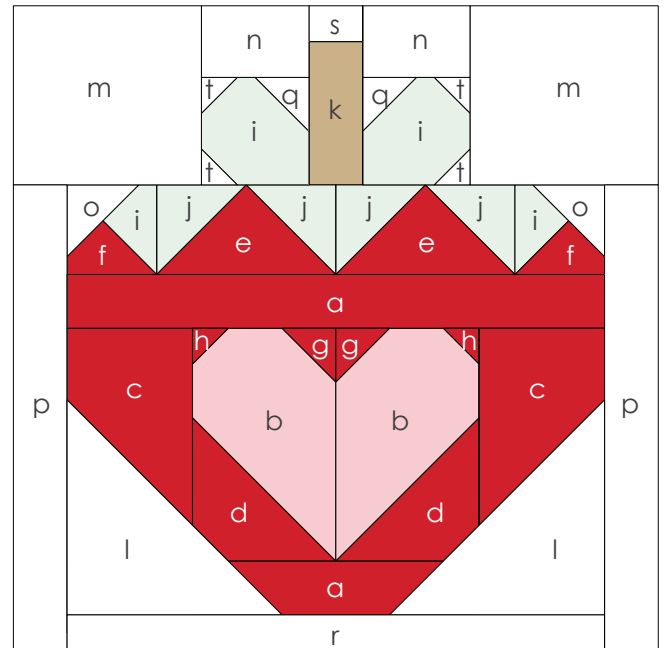
Sashing, Posts, and Binding

From leftover reds and pinks cut:

- (56) 2½" squares [u]

From background cut:

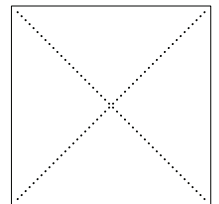
- (22) 2½" x WOF strips, cut into (97) 2½" x 9½" [v]
- (7) 1¼" x WOF strips, cut into (224) 1¼" squares [w]



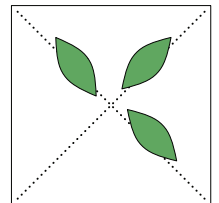
Make the Applique Blocks

Use your preferred applique method to assemble these blocks.

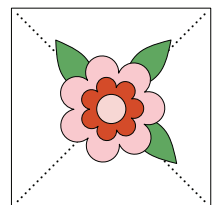
1. Finger-press 2 diagonal fold lines onto the background square to use as placement guides.



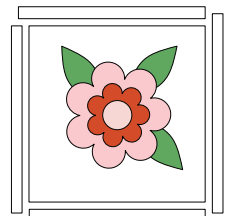
2. Applique the leaves.



3. First add the large flower, next the small flower, and then the center as shown.



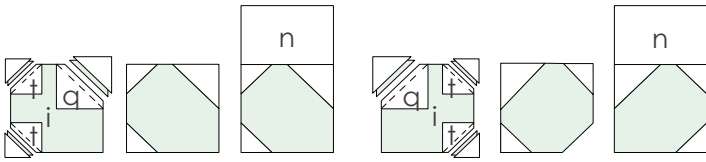
4. Trim to 9½" x 9½". Make 21 blocks.



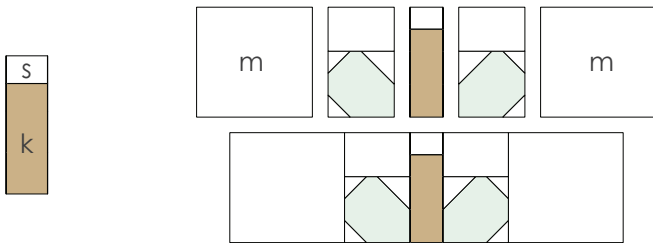
Make 21

Make Patchwork Blocks

1. Using Sew and Flip, add [q] and 2 [t] to [i] as shown. Pay attention to the placement of each triangle. Then add [n] to the top. Repeat to make the reverse as shown.

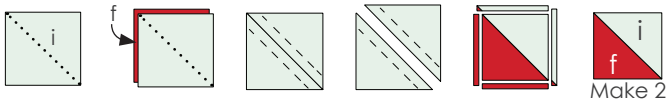


2. Join [s] and [k]. Then add the above units and 2 [m] as shown to make the stem unit.



4. Draw a line on the wrong side [i]. Lay [i] and [f] with right sides together. Sew a 1/4" seam along both sides of the line. Cut on the drawn line.

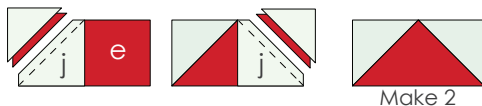
Trim both squares 1 3/4" x 1 3/4". Make 2 HSTs.



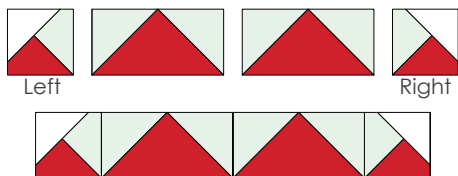
5. Using Sew and Flip, add [o] to an HST to make the left HST. Repeat to make the right HST, paying attention to the orientation as shown.



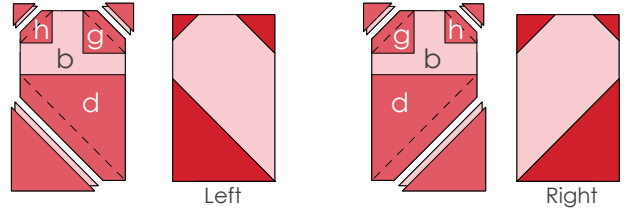
6. Using Sew and Flip, add 2 [j] to [e] to make a flying geese unit. Make 2.



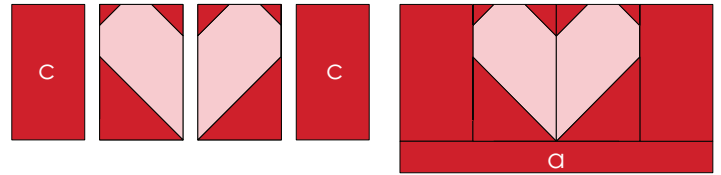
7. Join the above units as shown to make the cap unit.



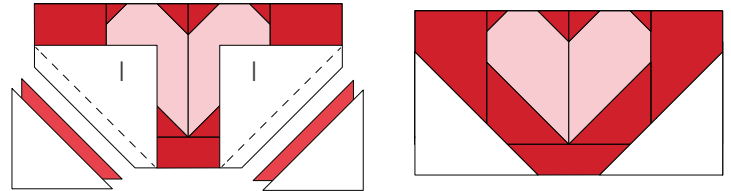
8. Using Sew and Flip, add [h], [g], and [d] to [b] as shown to make the left heart unit. Repeat to make the right heart unit, paying attention to the orientation.



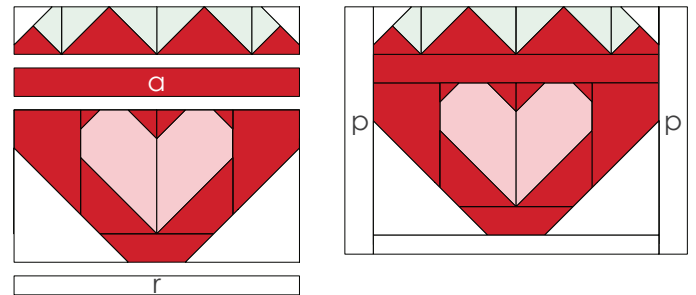
9. Join the heart units and 2 [c] as shown. Then add [a].



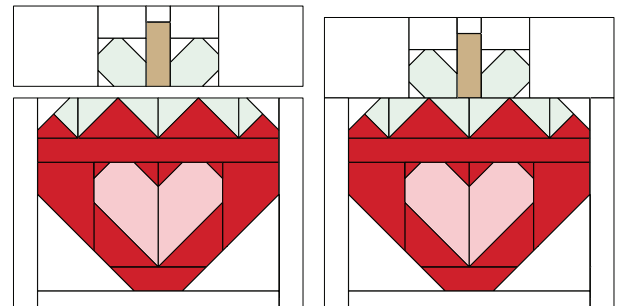
10. Using Sew and Flip, add 2 [l] to make the heart unit.



11. Join the cap unit, [a], heart unit, and [r] as shown. Then add 2 [p].

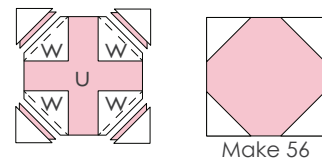


13. Add the stem unit to finish the block. Make 21 blocks.



Make Posts

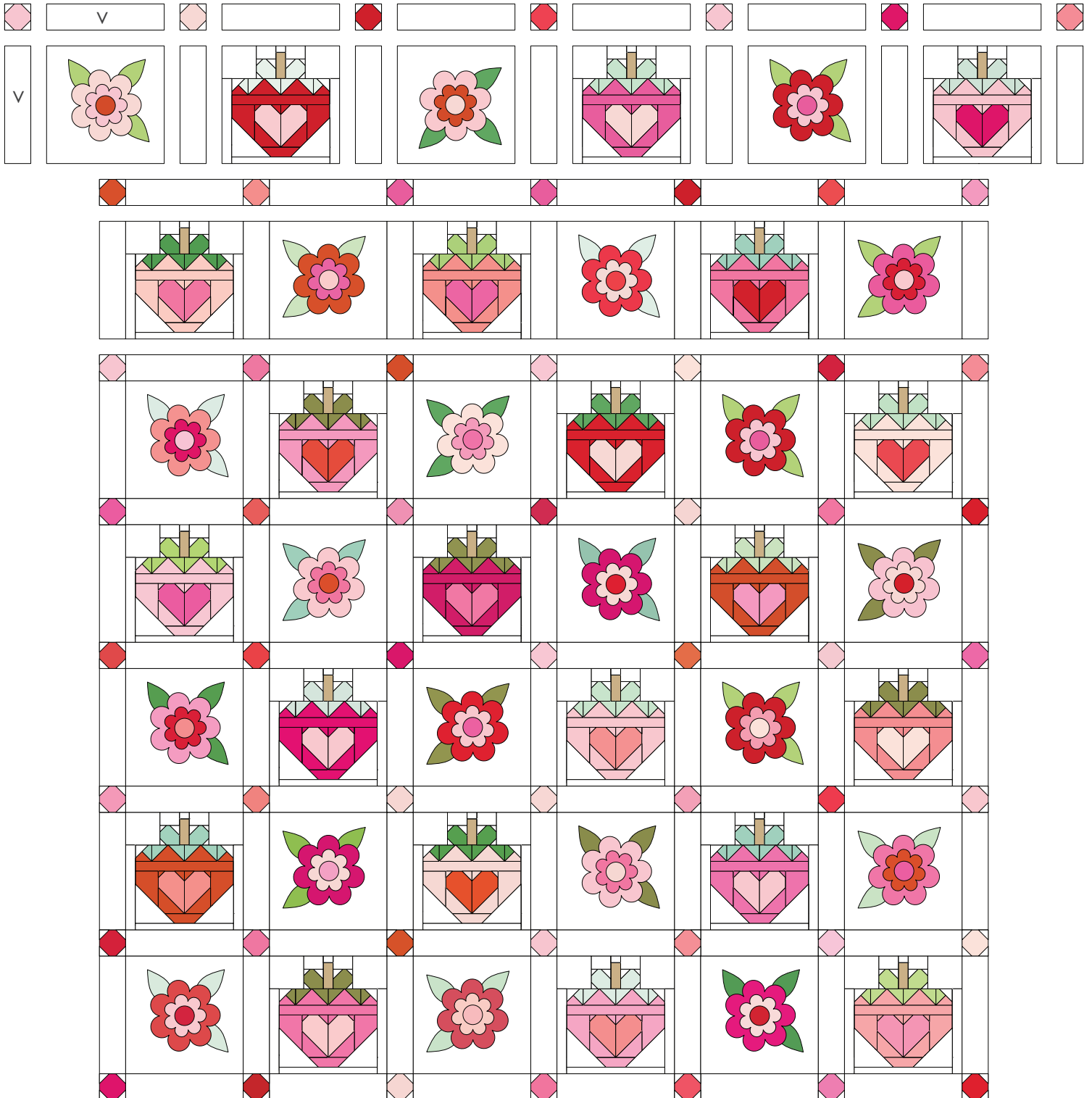
1. Using Sew and Flip, add 4 [w] to [u]. Make 56.



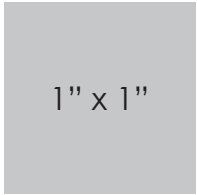
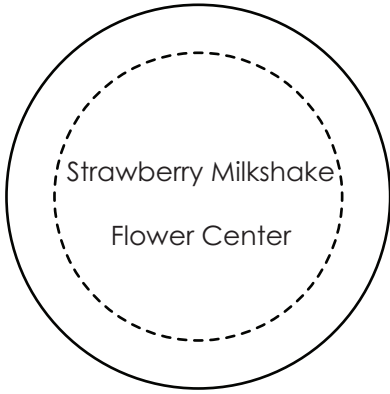
Assemble Quilt

1. Arrange the posts, 97 [v], and the blocks as shown, paying attention to the orientation of the applique blocks. Sew them together.

2. Quilt as desired and bind.
