

- You need: 2 fat eighths (1 pink, 1 green)
3 fat quarters (1 white, 1 binding, 1 backing)
13" square of batting

Cutting Instructions

Seams are 1/4" and pressed open.

From leaf fabric cut:

- (4) 4" × 2¼" [a]

From berry fabric cut:

- (1) 4½" × 9½" [b]
- (1) 4" × 3¼" [c]
- (1) 4" × 1½" [d]
- (1) 4" × 2¼" [e]
- (4) 2¼" squares [f]

From background fabric cut:

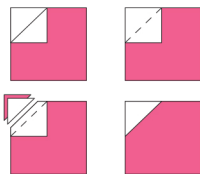
- (1) 4" × 4¾" [g]
- (2) 4" squares [h]
- (1) 4" × 3" [i]
- (1) 4" × 2¼" [j]
- (4) 2¼" squares [k]
- (2) 2" × 8" [m]
- (2) 1½" squares [n]
- (2) 1" × 12½" [o]

From binding fabric cut:

- (3) 2¼" strips, piece for length

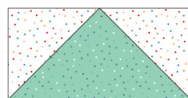
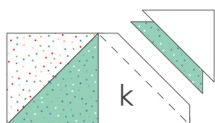
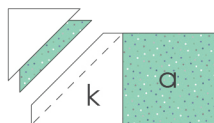
Stitch & Flip Technique

1. Draw a diagonal line on the top square.
2. Place top square onto adjoining fabric RST, aligning the edges. Stitch on the line.
3. Trim the corner, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
4. Flip the top square over. Press seam open.



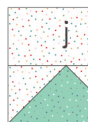
Assembly Instructions

1. Using Stitch & Flip, add 2 [k] to [a]. Make 2 flying geese.

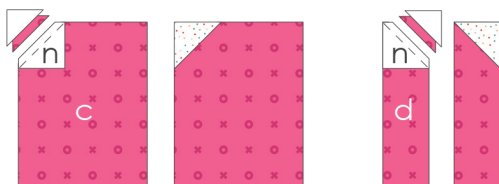
2. Join [j] to a flying geese as shown. Then add the other flying geese, [i] and [g] as shown.



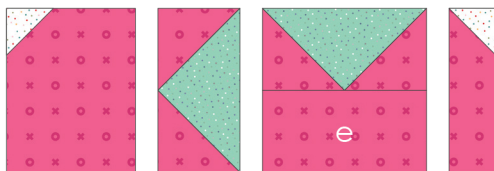
3. Repeat step 1 with 2 [f] and [a].
Make 2 flying geese.



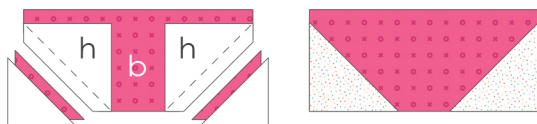
4. Using Stitch & Flip, add [n] to [c]. Add [n] to [d].



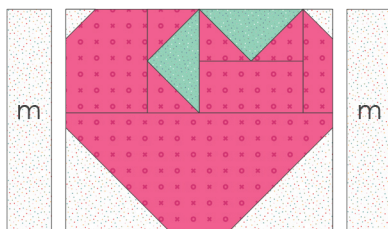
5. Join [e] to a flying geese as shown. Then add the other flying geese and sections from steps 3 and 4 as shown.



6. Using Stitch & Flip, add 2 [h] to [b].



7. Join the sections from steps 5 and 6. Then add 2 [m].



8. Join the sections from steps 2 and 7 as shown. Add 2 [o].

9. Layer the pieced strawberry, batting, and backing. Baste, quilt as desired, and bind.
