Philanthropy and community involvement are at the core of Plum's culture and we believe that each garment is Stitched With Purpose[™].

Our "Plum Cares" Collection was founded in 2016 to raise funds for causes and give back to our worldwide community. Inspired by Emily McGill, a gymnast from Wall, NJ who was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma, Plum developed a campaign "A leo can save a life" where \$10 from each purchase of 6,000 leos was donated back to Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) and St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. From supporting gymnasts with life-threatening diseases, raising funds after catastrophic events such as hurricanes and fires, to furthering athlete's education; Plum has raised and contributed over \$100,000+ through this collection's inception.

Plum's current focus is education and has established an annual educational scholarship called the Plum Cares Academic Scholarship (PCAS). This year the scholarship is \$1,000.

The Scholarship's Purpose

The PCAS was founded by Plum Practicewear in conjunction with their Plum Cares Collection to inspire the next generation of student-athletes by offering an academic scholarship for a graduating high school senior that has not been awarded a full athletic scholarship.

Amount

One winner will receive a one-time scholarship totaling \$1,000. Plum reserves the right to break up the \$1,000 and recognize multiple winners as needed.

Scholarship Eligibility

The scholarship is given to a gymnast who is:

- A high school senior.
- A legal resident of the United States of America.
- Entering an academic institution (college, university, or trade school) in the fall of 2024.
- A competitive gymnast within one of the following disciplines: artistic, rhythmic, acrobatic, tumbling, and/or trampoline.
- Home-schooled students may apply for the scholarship as long as their home school program progress is equivalent to that of a high school senior.

- The winner will not be based on financial need, but on the quality of submission.
- Complete the attached 5-page application which includes a 500 word essay.
- Please provide a copy of your most recent school transcript.
- Relatives/family members of Plum staff are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.


