Fabric Requirements	
Hearts and Bart	(26 -28) 2½" x 2½" Scraps
Background Fabric	(1) 4½" x 8½" Rectangle (1) 4½" x 10½" Rectangle (2) 12½" x 4½" Rectangles (3) 16½" x 4½" Rectangles
Additional Supplies	
Heat n Bond Lite	6" Strip Off The Roll
Printed Heart Template, Pencil, Frixion Pen, Scissors, Mini Scissors, Iron and Board, Coordinating Thread, and Sewing Machine.	

#### **Before Starting**

- Please read each section before starting.
- Print out Heart Template, page 7.

#### Select "Actual Size" in your print settings.

• The applique method used is fused smooth edge applique with a zig zag stitch width of 2.5 and stitch length of 1.0.

#### **Tracing Pieces Onto Heat n Bond**

1. With Heat n Bond paper side up, place on printed Heart Template, with pencil trace all motifs onto Heat n Bond paper side. Or cut out paper Heart Template and trace onto Heat n Bond paper side. Trace (25) hearts and 1 Bart.

#### Fusing Heat n Bond And Fabric

2. With Fabric Scraps wrong side up place coordinating Heat n Bond traced heart motifs paper side up on top, following Heat n Bond manufacture's directions, press.

#### **Cutting Motifs**

3. Cut out each fused heart motif.

#### **Placing Heart Motifs**

- 4. Peel off paper backing from heart motifs.
- 5. Using the Placement Measurements on page 6, place heart motifs on background fabric.

#### **Fusing Hearts Onto Background**

6. Press heart motifs, following Heat n Bond manufacture's directions, fusing onto background fabric.

#### **Machine Stitching**


- 7. Choose the Zig Zag stitch on your sewing machine.
- 8. Set the stitch to a stitch width of 2.5 and a stitch length of 1.0.
- 9. Use coordinating thread to stitch each heart motif. You can either backstitch when starting and stopping, or I like to pull the threads to the back and tie a knot.


Now your pretty filler blocks are all ready to go into your Sprout quilt!




