

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Release forms must be signed by everyone over 18 to enter Cub Mountain ATV Park
2. All guests must register
3. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian
4. All operators/passengers must follow all manufacturer's safe operating procedures at all times.
5. Riding double on ATV's is prohibited except on ATV's designed for double by the factory
6. DOT approved helmets must be worn by everyone under 18
7. Ride only on marked trails. Do not blaze new trails. Cutting or damaging trees is prohibited.
8. Some trails have 2-way traffic. Be alert!
9. Posted speed limit must be followed.
10. No Alcohol allowed on trails at any time.
11. There is no hunting allowed at any time within the Park.
12. All fishing will be catch and release only.
13. Swimming is strictly prohibited in any body of water located on the property.
14. No Littering. Pack it in – Pack it out. Violators will be fined or barred from the Park.
15. No firearms allowed.
16. There will be no tolerance for fighting.
17. Explosives/fireworks, Illegal substances and glass are prohibited at all times anywhere within the Park.
18. Management not responsible for damage, loss, theft or personal property or injury to visitors.
19. No profanity. Be considerate. This is a family friendly park.
20. Quiet time shall be from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am
21. Radios/TV's and other electronic equipment volume must be as not to disturb others.
22. RV sewer connections must be made using a secure, leak proof adapter
23. Dogs must be accompanied and leashed when outdoors. Aggressive or barking dogs will not be tolerated. All animal waste must be cleaned up in plastic bags and deposited in the dumpster.
24. All illegal or unauthorized activity is strictly prohibited.
25. Cub Mountain ATV Park LLC has the right to deny entry to or removal from Park of anyone at any time at its sole discretion.
