- What characters do you think might be in this story?

DURING READING:

- What do you think will happen next? Why?
- How do you think Raja will respond to the situation?
- How do you think Kamal will respond to the situation?
- What would you have done if you were Raja? Why?
- Has anything like this ever happened to you? Does it remind you of something?
- How would you feel if that happened to you?
- How are you like/different than Raja?
- Do you know someone like Raja? Or Kamal?
- Can you put what you've just read in your own words?

AFTER READING:

- What is the main message of this story?
- What does the author want you to think about?
- Retell the most important events in the story from beginning, middle and end.
- What were the most important events in this story?
- How does Raja feel at the end of the story?
- How would you describe Raja? How would you describe Kamal? Use examples from the text.
- What was your favorite part of the story?
- How did Kamal change throughout the story?
- What else could Raja have done if that didn't work?
