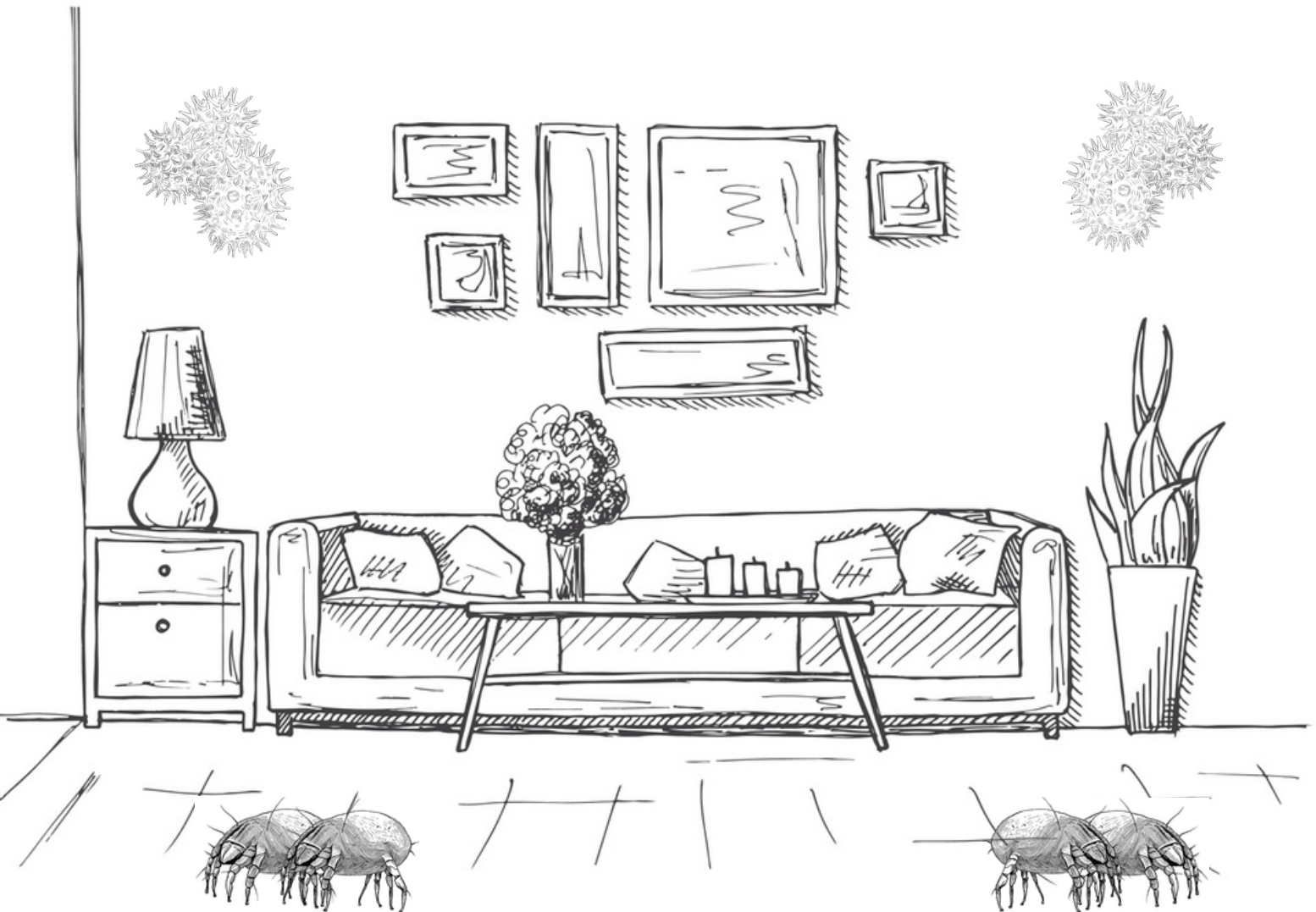
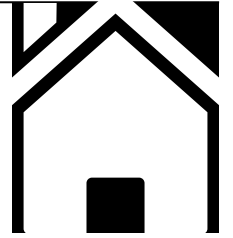
It cannot be over-emphasized that proper cleaning and maintenance is a critical component of any flooring system.

Steam Carpet Cleaning Clears Dust Mites

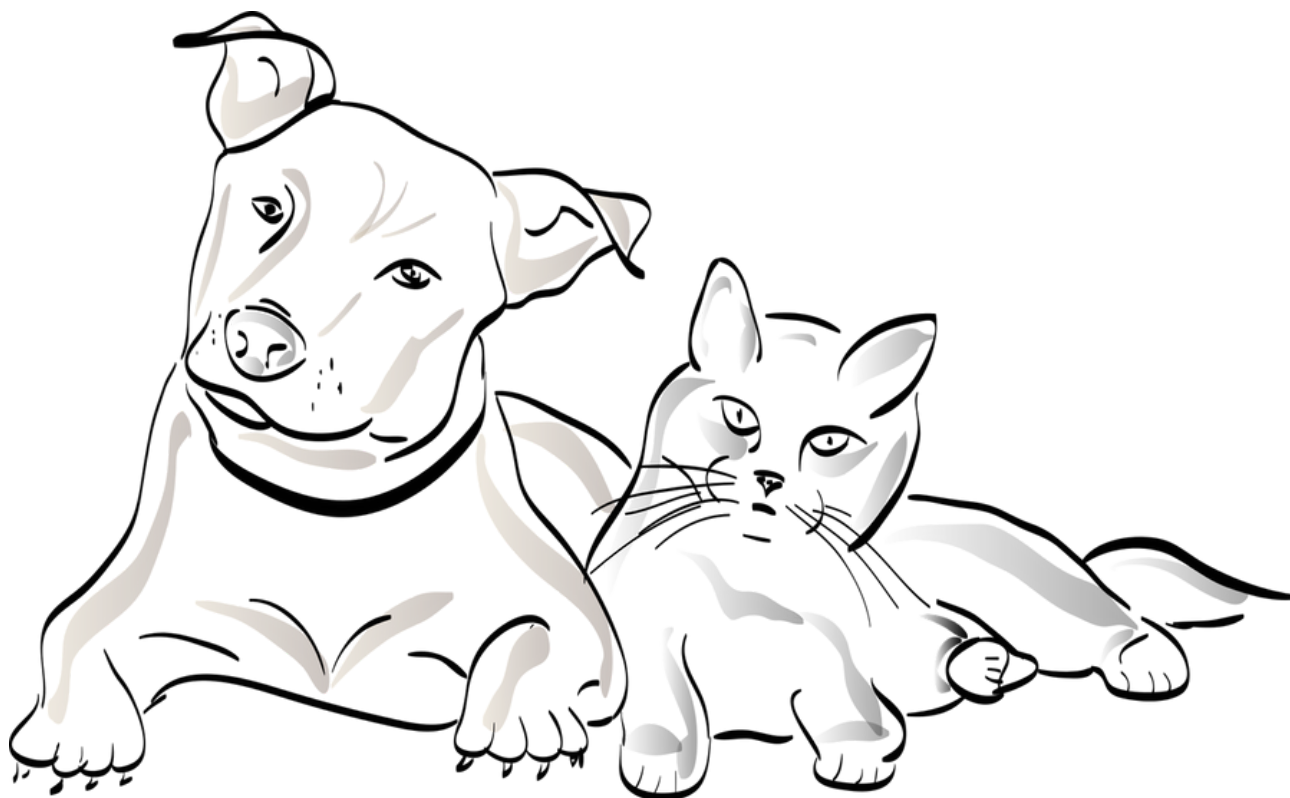

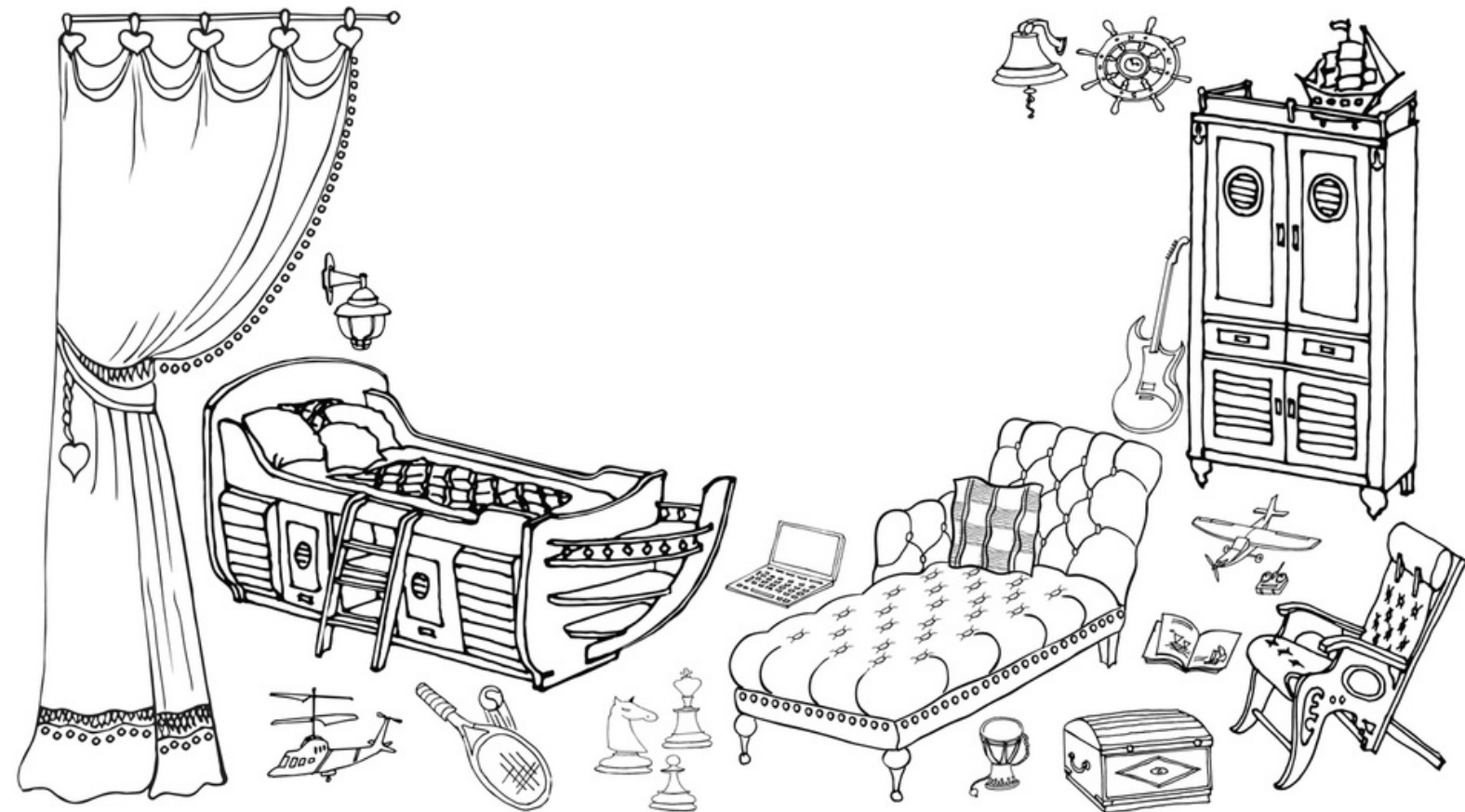
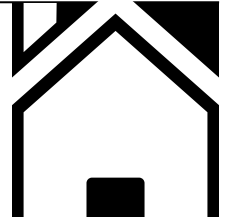

WHAT DIRTY CARPETS CAN DO TO KIDS

For many parents, the concern over what a dirty carpet can do to their children's health outweighs the cosmetic annoyances of stains and spills. Allergens buried in carpet fibers can cause problems for children and adults alike. Common examples of these allergens include dust, dander, skin mites, insect parts, pollen, and mold.

A child exposed to carpet-based allergens may show symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, wheezing, a sore throat, a runny nose, shortness of breath, and watery eyes. If your kids regularly suffer from these issues at home, suspect the presence of carpet allergens.

WHY STEAM CLEANING MAKES SENSE

Steam cleaning may prove the most sensible solution for your carpet cleaning needs, especially if you have children who suffer from close proximity to bacteria. Water heated to over 200 degrees Fahrenheit turns into steam that gets deep into the carpet fibers, killing germs, dust mites, and other irritants.

HOW IT WORKS

HOW DO WE CLEAN YOUR CARPETS?

Our carpet machines are equipped with a high-powered twin vacuum system that extracts dirt from deep inside the carpet fibres. We never over-wet your carpets or use harsh carpet cleaning chemicals. Carpets are always left free of detergent and rinsed with a solution to bring your carpet fibres back to the pH level they were when new, ensuring the carpet and everyone's health is maintained!

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE FOR THE CARPETS TO DRY?

Thanks to our high-powered machines, your carpets will be around 80% dry when we finish. Typically, carpets take between 2 to 4 hours to dry completely. We advise keeping windows and doors open, if feasible, to improve air circulation and ventilation, and turning on the heating if needed to assist the drying process further.

DO I NEED TO HOOVER THE AREA BEFORE YOU ARRIVE?

You don't need to Hoover before our arrival, we will do that for you as it helps to remove dry loose soil from the carpet fibres.

ARE THE PRODUCTS YOU USE CHILD AND PET FRIENDLY?

Yes, the products we use are safe for children and pets.

WHERE IS THE WASTEWATER DISPOSED OF?

Upon completion, we dispose of wastewater down either an external kitchen drain or an internal toilet. This is to ensure our commitment to proper disposal of wastewater from our machines.
