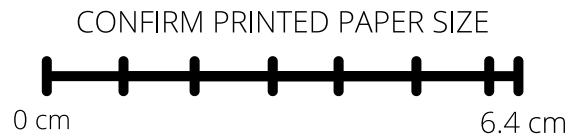




Be sure to set your printer to 100% before printing this ring sizing guide.



To confirm that the above bar is printed precisely at 6,4 cm, or 2,52 inches, measure it. Ring size measurements won't be accurate if they are not formatted correctly.

Once printed, check the printed paper size in the box to the right with a ruler. This is crucial since your ring size won't be accurate if the page prints incorrectly.

To ensure that your ring size is as precise as possible, make sure to measure your finger at room temperature and several times throughout the day.

Find your ring size

1. Measure the diameter of an existing, properly-fitting ring with a ruler (in mm). Utilize our ring sizing chart to determine your size.
2. When you can align the inside edge of your ring with one of the circles, place it over the circles above. The black line inside the ring ought to be visible.
3. If you are in between sizes, get the middle quarter size (i.e. 6.75).

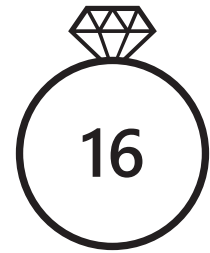

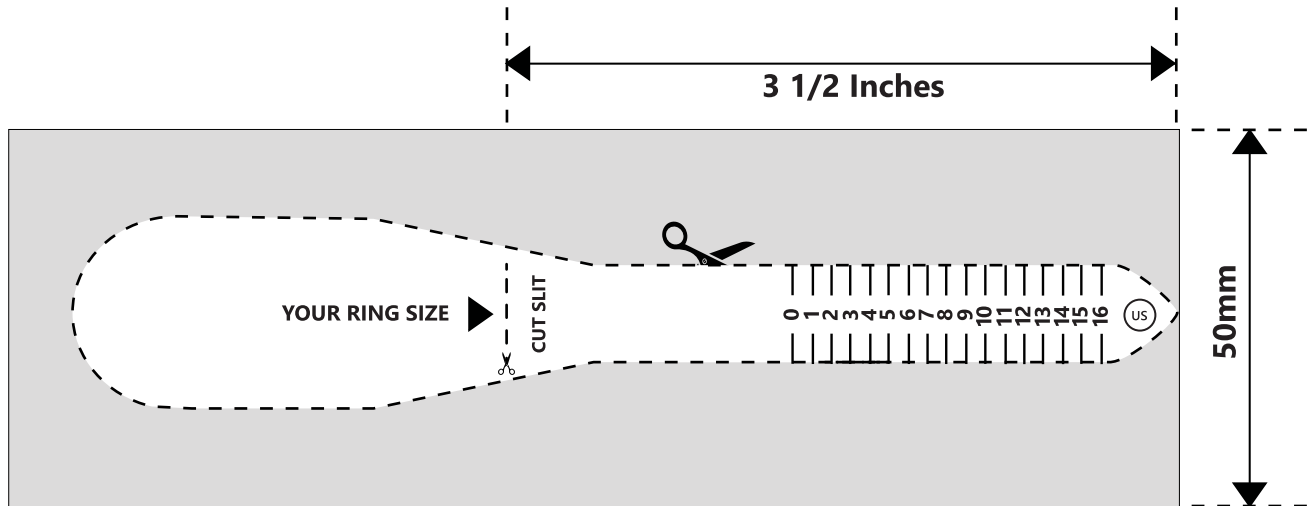

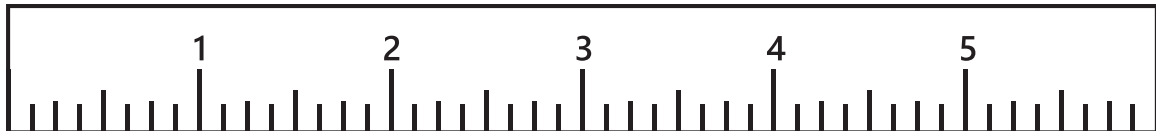
