

D-Solv 60 Degreaser

A highly active solvent based, aqueous degreaser. Excellent for degreasing skins such as bear, beaver, fox, coyote, muskrats, raccoons, and other like skins. Developed for the taxidermy and tanning industry.

Directions and Recommended use:

For the best results, this treatment process should be done at room temperature, 65° F or warmer. Wear apron, splash proof goggles and rubber gloves to avoid any eye or skin irritation.

D-Solv 60 can be added to an existing rehydration bath or pickle bath. Or you can create a fresh degreasing bath.

Rehydration and/or Pickle Bath: Use 1 ounce of *D-Solv 60* per **each** gallon of mixed rehydration or pickle bath. *Note: If salt is not already in the mixed baths, then add ¹/₄ lb (or 1/3 cup) of table salt per each gallon.*

Degreasing Bath: If a separate degreasing bath is necessary, it is recommended to be done after the skin is shaved. In a plastic or fiberglass container large enough to completely submerge the skin(s) and allow it to move freely, mix 2 ounces of *D-Solv 60* and $\frac{1}{2}$ lb (or 2/3 cup) of fine grain table salt per **each** gallon of water. Soak 3 - 4 hours, or up to 8 hours for greasier or thicker skins.

Degreasing Extremely Greasy Skins: Rehydrate the skin as best you can and then drain. Using a soft brush, apply an application of undiluted *D-Solv 60* to the flesh side, fold the skin flesh side to flesh side for 6 hours. If the fur also feels greasy, apply a thin coat to this side too. Then rinse thoroughly in lukewarm water to remove excess grease before placing the skin back in the rehydration or pickle bath (see above).

For Grease Burned Skins: Use Hide Relaxer XL7 and follow the directions for this product.

Note: Do not place a skin in hot water as this can cause bacteria growth and loosen the hair/fur.

Precautionary Statement: Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.

First Aid: Causes eye irritation and may irritate skin causing dryness. *If in Eyes:* Rinse with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. *If on Skin and Clothing:* Wash skin with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing. If skin or eye irritation persists, get medical attention. Store product closed in original container in a cool, dry area.
