If your bathroom has studded/plasterboard walls, pleases use appropriate plasterboard fixings. Please ensure the wall can take weight of units detailed above. Before installing a wooden bathroom unit into a new property, extension or recently plastered room we strongly advise the building/room is completely dry, well ventilated and adequately heated.

### **FIXINGS**



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#### **1909 MIRROR INSTALLATION**



Mark he wall with the location of the fixings. Drill and install the wall fixing backplate. The fixings provided are for solid walls, for other wall types use specialist fixings.



Release the washer and hex nut, then assemble the mirror fixings to the fixing backplate tightening them by hand with the allen key provided, as shown in the diagram. Make sure it is a tight fit.



Place the mirror on the wall brackets and tighten with the washer and hex nut by hand, ensuring a tight fit. The pivot hinge can then be tightened by the grub screw on the underside of the pivot fixing.



Make sure the installation is level. Place the silicone protectors on the edges of the back of the mirror to avoid impact with the wall.

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## **1850 MIRROR INSTALLATION**



Mark the wall with the location of the fixings. Drill and install the mirror fixings. The fixings provided are for solid walls, for other wall types use specialist fixings.



Release the washer and hex nut.



Place the mirror on the wall brackets and tighten with the washer and hex nut by hand, ensuring a tight fit. The pivot hinge can then be tightened by the grub screw on the underside of the pivot fixing.



Make sure the installation is level. Place the silicone protectors on the edges of the back of the mirror to avoid impact with the wall.

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#### **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

Clean regularly using with warm soapy water and polish with only a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toiletries etc. should be rinsed off straight after use. Household bleaches and cleaners containing harsh chemicals may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar. Lime-scale marks can be cleaned using a diluted lime-scale remover used in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
