

# Classic Beefsteak Tomato



Also known as Red Ponderosa or Crimson Cushion. Produces huge fruit, easily reaching 1-2 lbs. and offers a good old-fashioned tomato flavor.

These tomatoes are meaty and firm, perfect on sandwiches or served straight up with a pinch of salt. Indeterminate.

# Better Boy Tomato



Rugged vines produce large crops of bright red, 12 to 16 oz. smooth, flavorful fruit. Similar to Big Boy, but with additional disease resistance. Firm and perfect for slicing. One of the best tasting hybrid garden tomatoes. Indeterminate.

# Better Boy Plus Tomato



A bit sweeter than Better Boy with greater fruit setting, disease resistance, and adaptability.

Produces firm, unbelievably juicy, bright red 12-16 oz tomatoes.

# Beefmaster Tomato



One of America's favorites for the solid, meaty, flavorful red fruit that weighs up to 2 lbs. Vigorous vines and outstanding flavor and quality. Great for sandwiches or slicing to eat fresh! Indeterminate.

# Big Beef Tomato



Top choice for fresh market beefsteak tomatoes. Large, 10-12 oz with full flavor and ripening early for their size. Indeterminate.

# Big Boy Tomato



A long time favorite because of its very large, smooth scarlet fruit with meaty flesh and great flavor. Heavy crops peak in midseason but continue until frost. Great for sandwiches or for slicing to eat fresh!

# Celebrity Tomato



Medium-large flavorful, globe-shaped, firm and red fruits ripen midseason. Widely adapted. High resistance to disease. Vigorous vines with heavy yields!  
Determinate.

# Early Girl Tomato



A longtime early favorite, Early Girl produces heavy yields of full-flavored, 4–6 oz. tomatoes. One of the first varieties to ripen each year. Extreme tolerance to drought and blossom end-rot. High resistance to disease. Indeterminate.



# Amana Orange Tomato



Huge heirloom orange  
beefsteak that can  
grow to 2 pounds and  
more, with an average  
diameter of 5 inches.

Flavor is mild and  
quite pleasant.

Heirloom variety  
named for Amana,  
Iowa. Indeterminate.

# Amish Paste Tomato



Large for a sauce tomato, Amish Paste's slightly irregular plum to strawberry-shaped fruits average 8-12 oz. with excellent flavor. These meaty tomatoes are good in salads and great for processing! Indeterminate.

# Black Cherry Tomato



Sweet and robust fruits are a pleasant purple-brown color. Regarded as one of the best tasting cherry tomatoes. High yielding and maturing to 1.5 inches. Indeterminate.

# Black Krim Tomato



The Black Krim combines bold, smoky flavor and good texture with an unusual appearance. Deep brown/red, 8-16 oz. tomatoes have brown/green shoulders that get darker with more heat and sunlight. High yielding. Indeterminate.

# Brad's Atomic Grape Tomato



The color (and flavor!) is a full-blown assault on the senses—lavender and purple stripes, turning to technicolor olive-green, red, and brown/blue stripes when fully ripe. Fruit holds well on the vine or off. Olive green interior is blushed with red when ripe. Crack-resistant fruit is extraordinarily sweet! Indeterminate.

# Brandywine Tomato



Brandywine's luscious, heirloom flavor is very rich, loud, and distinctively spicy. The large fruits, often over 1 lb., have a deep-pink skin and smooth, red flesh. It is popularly considered among the best tasting tomatoes. These medium-tall, potato-leaf plants are best staked or caged. Indeterminate.

# Brandywine Black Tomato



The Brandywine Black tomato is extra large and full of the deep, earthy and sweet flavor that has made blackish-purple tomatoes so popular.

This variety offers heavy yields and is superior for salsa and cooking. A great home garden variety that will surely become a favorite!

# Cherokee Carbon Tomato



Crack-resistant Cherokee Purple! Blocky-round, 10-14 oz. tomatoes boast the signature rich flavor and meaty texture of a classic black tomato. Excellent yields and fruit quality. Productive over a longer period than similar types. Indeterminate.



# Cherokee Chocolate Tomato



A stabilized version of Cherokee Purple, this 10 to 16 oz. mahogany-colored variety has excellent flavor and beautiful large fruit. Very productive plants are vigorous and yield a large harvest of these chocolate-colored tomatoes with ample size and wonderful flavor.

# Cherokee Green Tomato



A wonderful variation of Cherokee Purple, featuring green-fleshed fruit blushed with amber at the blossom end. Medium to large, 8 to 12 oz. tomatoes have a remarkable flavor that is complex and delicious. Combined with great productivity and a good measure of disease tolerance, Cherokee Green offers luscious tomatoes considered by many as the best tasting green-colored fruits. Indeterminate.

# Cherokee Purple Tomato



Famously rich flavor and texture make this a colorful favorite among heirloom enthusiasts. Medium-large, flattened globe, 8-12 oz. fruits. Color is dusky pink with dark shoulders. Multicolor interior ranges from purple to brown to green. Relatively short vines. Indeterminate.

# German Pink Tomato



Deep pink beefsteak fruits have excellent, sweet flavor and are meaty with few seeds. Tomatoes weigh between 10 and 16 oz. and are fairly smooth in shape.

Potato-leaved plants produce these large, delectable tomatoes early in the season. Heirloom variety. Indeterminate.

# German Johnson Tomato



More vigorous, higher yielding Brandywine type pink heirloom. 8-16 oz fruit have lots of deep, acidic tomato flavor and a rich texture.

# Gold Medal Tomato



Smooth, 1-3 pound bi-colored fruits are yellow with a rosy red radiating from the blossom end. Sweet, mild, low acid taste that is great for fresh eating.

# Goliath Tomato



Giant heirloom fruit on a huge plant! 1-2 pound dark pink, solid tomatoes are ribbed, have few seeds, and are very sweet yet have an acid component balancing the flavor.

# Homestead Tomato



Short and stout heirloom plant that produces an abundance of 8-10 oz fruit. Heat tolerant, great all purpose tomato that does really well in hot and humid conditions. Semi-determinate.



# Early Girl Tomato



A longtime early favorite, Early Girl produces heavy yields of full-flavored, 4–6 oz. tomatoes. One of the first varieties to ripen each year. Extreme tolerance to drought and blossom end-rot. High resistance to disease. Indeterminate.

# Great White Tomato



Heirloom variety.  
Beautiful, large white  
beefsteak tomato with  
sweet flavor and lots of  
juice. Fruit is larger than  
that of White Beauty.  
Vigorous plants have  
heavy foliage that  
provides good protection  
against sun-scald on the  
fruit. Indeterminate.

# Green Zebra Tomato



A delicious, tangy salad tomato, ripe just as the green fruit develops a yellow blush, accentuating the darker green stripes. The 3–4 oz. fruits are the ideal size for slicing into wedges for salads.

Productive over a long season. Indeterminate.

# Hawaiian Pineapple Tomato



Golden-orange beefsteak fruits grow up to 1-1/2 lbs. and have a pineapple-like flavor when ripe. Fruits are incredibly rich, fruity and sweet. As a bonus, you can expect very large harvests of these wonderful tomatoes! Indeterminate.

# Indigo Blue Beauty Tomato



Beautiful 6- 8 oz. beefsteak tomatoes are uniquely colored, beginning as a stunning true blue atop & bottom side green. As they ripen fully, the purple deepens and eventually turns more reddish- that's when they are ready to harvest! Expect a heavy production of meaty tomatoes that are resistant to cracking and hold well on the vine until you are ready to pick them. Indeterminate.

# Indigo Rose Tomato



Indigo Rose develops a dark purple skin wherever the fruit is exposed to direct sun. It is not ripe until the fruit softens, the bottom turns from green to red, and the flesh is deep red. Expect an abundance of these very beautiful 1 to 2 oz. deep purple fruits with rosy undersides and deep, brick red flesh. Indeterminate.

# Indigo Cherry Drops Tomato



Vigorously produces striking, large clusters of tasty 1-2 oz red flesh fruits with dark blue coloration. Indigo varieties have high antioxidants and great flavor. Indeterminate.

# Japanese Black Trifele Tomato



Heirloom with unusual pear shape and burgundy color.

Good yields of 4–6 oz. fruit with excellent, rich flavor. Harvest when shoulders are still green for best flavor. Potato-leaf variety.

# Juliet Tomato



Elongated cherry tomatoes grow in grape-like clusters and load up on vigorous vines. The 1 oz fruit has red, glossy skin and wonderful sweet flavor. The fruit is crack-resistant and holds on the vine better than most cherries. Expect high yields from plants that are tolerant to late blight and leaf spot. Indeterminate.

# Kellogg's Breakfast Tomato



Lovely pale-orange color on 1 lb. beefsteak type fruit. Tomatoes have very good flavor and are quite meaty with few seeds. Juice has the same bright color as orange juice and is delicious. Heirloom variety. Indeterminate.

# Lemon Boy Plus Tomato



Bright-yellow, lemon-colored version of the Better Boy. Great producer of 6-8 oz fruits with the perfect balance of sweet and tangy flavors. Indeterminate.

# Lucky Tiger Tomato



Elongated 2-inch fruit comes in stunning jewel toned shades of green and red with hints of gold. Tangy, sweet and complex flavor with balanced acidity.

# Martha Washington Tomato



Hybrid tomato with  
heirloom-quality!  
Reliably produces globe  
shaped pink fruit  
weighing 8-12oz.  
Indeterminate.

# Matt's Wild Cherry Tomato



These small cherry tomatoes are deep-red, tender, smooth, and full-flavored with a high sugar content. Fantastic in salsa and for fresh eating. Some resistance to early blight and late blight. Indeterminate.

# Mortgage Lifter Tomato



An old pink variety still in demand by gardeners. Well-shaped, large fruit is very meaty with few seeds; similar to Giant Belgium, but not quite as big. Folklore says this variety was named by a man who sold this crop to pay off a farm he was about to lose.

# Mr. Stripey Tomato



High sugar content in this heirloom tomato plant that yields beautiful multi-colored slicing tomatoes up to 1 lb. in size.

# Pink Berkeley Tie Dye Tomato



Unique appearance with heirloom-quality flavor. The compact 8-12 oz. fruits are dark pink with green striping, and the flesh is pink with yellow streaks! The flavor is outstanding - sweet and complex. Indeterminate.

# Pink Oxheart Tomato



This heart-shaped heirloom offers timeless old-fashioned flavor. The fruits are very juicy and meaty, with deep-pink flesh. Plants produce fruit up to 12 ounces in weight, on robust indeterminate plants that are very productive!

# Porkchop Tomato



This tomato is a beautiful lemon yellow when ripe with a sweet flavor that has a refreshing citrus component. The 8 to 12 oz. yellow tomatoes start off with thin green stripes that ripen to yellow at first and progress to a golden orange. Indeterminate.

# Roma Tomato



One of the most popular varieties for paste, sauces and canning. Compact vines yield large harvests of 3-inch long, bright red fruit that may be pear-shaped or plum-shaped. Thick walled and solid with few seeds. Determinate.

# Rutgers Tomato



Gardeners throughout the country are rediscovering this old-fashioned classic for its terrific flavor and productivity. This strain has some disease resistance, which ensures large crops of crack-free, bright red 6-8 oz. tomatoes with delicious old-time taste. For many years, this was a favorite for canning because of its abundance, juiciness and deep red color. Determinate.

# Supersweet 100 Tomato



The classic, sweet, red cherry tomato.

Supersweet 100 is a reliable cherry tomato with prolific yields and great flavor. Fruits produced in large clusters. Widely adapted.

High resistance to disease. Indeterminate.

# San Marzano Tomato



Considered one of the best paste tomatoes of all time with old-world look and taste. 4-6 oz vibrant red fruits peel easily and cook down quickly. Indeterminate.

# Speckled Roman Tomato



Truly special paste tomato that grows to 5 inches long and red with jagged golden stripes. Meaty, 6 to 8 oz, with very few seeds. Great for processing into sauce and paste yet so flavorful that you will also want to enjoy some fresh in salads. Vigorous plants produce heavily. Indeterminate.



# Striped German Tomato



These flat, medium-to-large tomatoes with variable shoulder ribbing are shaded yellow and red. The marbled interior looks beautiful sliced. Complex, fruity flavor and smooth texture. Medium-tall vines bear 12+ oz. fruit. Indeterminate.

# Sun Gold Tomato



Exceptionally sweet, bright tangerine-orange cherry tomatoes. Vigorous plants start yielding early and bear right through the season. The taste can't be beat! High resistance to fusarium wilt and tobacco mosaic virus.

# Sunrise Bumblebee Tomato



Gorgeous combination of yellows and reds, inside and out. Excellent sweet and tangy flavor. Adds a nice pop of color to any mix, but also stands alone as a premium-quality cherry for snacking and salads. Indeterminate.

# Tasmanian Chocolate Tomato



A delicious slicer for small spaces- great container plant! Produces 4-6 oz ribbed tomatoes that are richly flavored and perfect for slicing onto sandwiches. Determinate.

# Tiny Tim Tomato



Great container plant!  
These plants grow 12-18 inches tall and produce copious amounts of tiny 1 inch red tomatoes. Great sweet and tangy flavor. Dwarf determinate.

# Tommy Toe Tomato



Round to slightly elongated-shaped cherry tomato is bright red and prolific with excellent flavor and plenty of juice. This variety practically grows itself, resisting most diseases and setting loads of fruit. Great for salads and can even be used for juice. Australian Heirloom. Indeterminate.

# Valencia Tomato



Sunny orange fruits with full tomato flavor!

Round, smooth medium sized fruits average 8-10 oz.

Their meaty interiors have few seeds, and this

midseason tomato is among the best for both flavor and texture.

Indeterminate.

# Yellow Brandywine Tomato



This rich-flavored old timer is an orange version of Brandywine. The fruits are larger than Valencia. The Yellow Brandywine is a potato-leaf variety that is prolific and yields until frost. Indeterminate.



# Yellow Pear Tomato



These miniature pear-shaped tomatoes are 1.75 to 2 inches long and clear yellow in color. They are delightfully sweet, considered by many as 'garden candy'. Baskets of these are as pretty as can be. Tall plants bear large and continuous harvests. Indeterminate.
