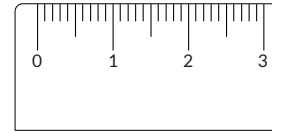




# Ring sizer - Guide to your size

How to measure your size with a ring you already own.

- 1) Print this page in A4, at 100%, and verify with a ruler that the measures on it are correct.
- 2) Take one of your rings that perfectly fits you and place it on the sheet where the circles are. Find the perfect size by matching the inner circumference of your ring with the outer edge of one of the circles.
- 3) **If the edge of the circle is visible inside the ring, you've found your size!**  
If in doubt between two sizes, we advise you to choose the bigger one.

If you own a calliper, follow these instructions.

- 1) Take one of your rings that perfectly fits you and **measure its inner circumference with a calliper (better if it's digital)**. Make the average of at least 2/3 measurements.
- 2) Compare the figure resulting from the measurement, rounded down, with the Ring Sizer above to find your size.
