





THE ART OF BONE CLEANING

Have you ever wondered about the remarkable journey behind the bones used in Uniquely Morbid's captivating art and jewelry creations? Our meticulous bone-cleaning process is an integral part of the art and jewelry creations that define Uniquely Morbid. By embracing this intricate journey, we ensure that every piece we craft possesses the essence of the macabre and the unusual. The smaller bones often come from owl pellets, where the vicious birds do all the hard work. All that's left for me to do is sift through the hairballs to retrieve these pristine bones.

For the larger bones, I let nature's tiniest helpers take the lead. Insects play a vital role as the ultimate cleaners, delicately consuming every trace of flesh in a natural cycle that guarantees each bone is impeccably clean.

Once the flesh is removed, the bones undergo a gentle cleansing bath in a simple mixture of water and mild Dawn dish soap. This soak, which can range from days to months, allows the dish soap to work its magic to eliminate lingering grease or oils.

After this refreshing soak, the bones are left to air dry, embracing the elements. They then experience a transformative peroxide bath, lasting approximately a week. This step further brightens and cleanses the bones, resulting in a pristine canvas.

Finally, the bones are allowed to air dry again, allowing their unique characteristics to shine through. While this process can be repeated as necessary, I often leave a gentle patina that imparts character to each bone.

CREATING SKELETON LEAVES

Creating and preserving skeleton leaves is a beautiful way to add an elegant touch of nature to your crafts and decorations. As we celebrate the beauty of nature in our D.I.Y. project, remember that these skeleton leaves can be incorporated into your macabre-themed art projects. They offer an elegant touch of the unusual, allowing you to infuse your creations with the beauty of the natural world.

Baking Soda Method:


