

COVER CARE FOR SPAS AND SWIMSPAS WITH OXFORD WEATHERSHIELD MATERIAL

Correct Spa Cover Care is important. Failure to follow these maintenance procedures can affect the life of your spa cover and its warranty.

How to clean your Oxford Weather Shield Cover:

- 1. Brush off any loose debris or dirt.
- 2. Spray on a cleaning solution of water and mild soap (such as washing up liquid.)
- 3. Use a soft bristle brush to clean.
- 4. Allow cleaning solution to soak into the fabric.
- 5. Rinse thoroughly until *all* soap residue is removed.
- 6. Air dry and lay flat.
- 7. Refit the spa cover.

Tips:

- Avoid using a hard bristle brush, this could cause abrasive damage to the cover fibres.
- You should only air dry the cover. Do not attempt to dry the cover with other methods.
- Do not use bleach or other chemical solvents that may discolour the Oxford Weather Shield fabric.
- Do not attempt to rub liquid spills. If a spill occurs attempt to blot the liquid with a clean, dry cloth. For oil-based liquids, apply an absorbent and let this sit for 10 minutes (e.g., corn starch) and remove using a straight edge.
- Always ensure you have thoroughly rinsed and removed all soap residue before use.
