

COVER CARE FOR SPAS AND SWIMSPAS WITH VINYL COVERS

Correct Spa cover care is important. Failure to follow these maintenance procedures can affect the life of your spa cover and its warranty.

The spa cover should be cleaned twice each month, it is important to use a good quality cover cleaner or saddle soap.

- 1. Proper spa water chemistry is an important factor in extending the performance life of your cover.
- 2. Remove the spas cover form the spa and lay it flat.
- 3. Rinse the cover both sides with clean fresh water.
- 4. Use a soft bristle brush and scrub the cover clean with an Aqua Design & Leisure cover cleaner or a mild soap solution, a tea spoon of dishwashing liquid or car shampoo to a bucket of warm water.

CAUTION – DO NOT let the soap solution dry on the surface of the cover and rinse thoroughly and dry.

- 5. Apply a good quality saddle soap.
- 6. Refit the spa cover.
- 7. On a regular basis, open the spa cover to allow any accumulated chemical vapours to dissipate.
- 8. Twice a year turn the cover upside down on the spa for 3-4 hours.
- 9. Although your spa cover is made of the finest UV stabilised vinyl it may become brittle and age prematurely if it is not cleaned as set above.

Your cover warranty could be void if the warranty activation card is not returned or the online warranty form is not completed within 14 days of purchase.
