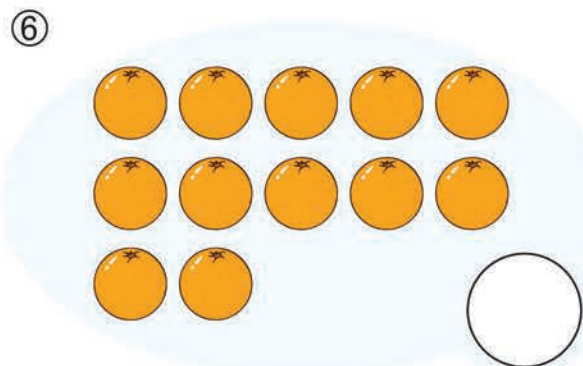
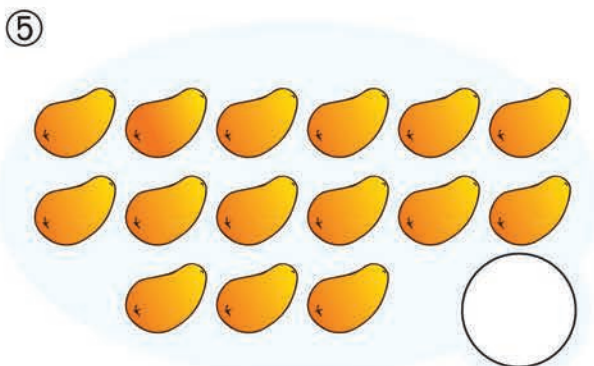
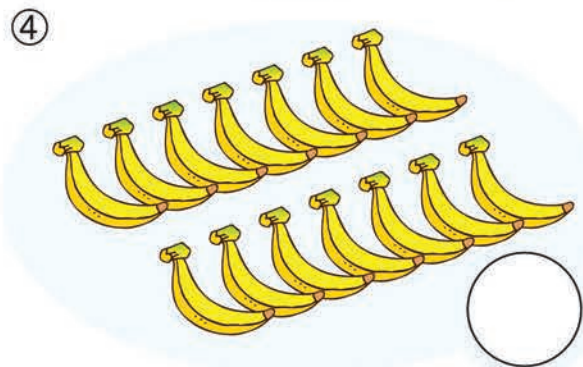
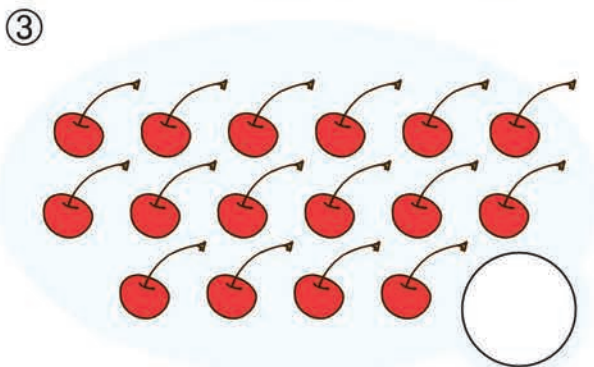
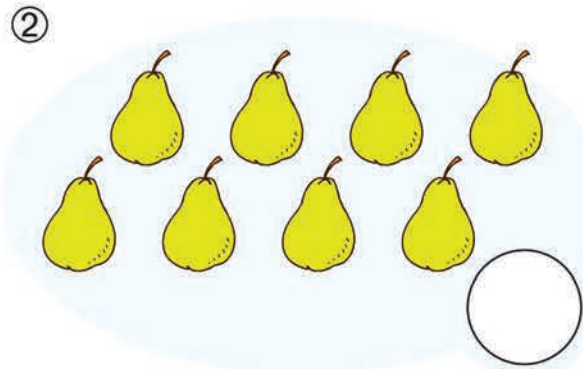
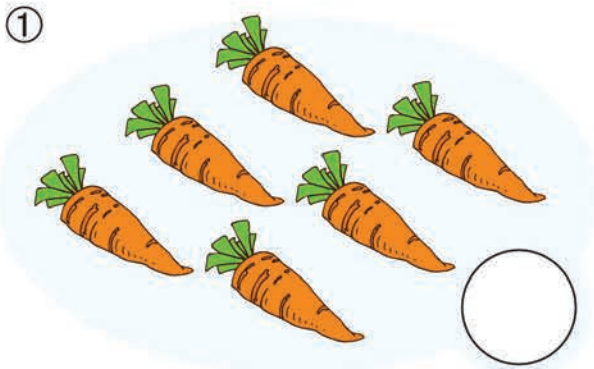
## Numbers 1 to 20

## Singular and Plural Nouns

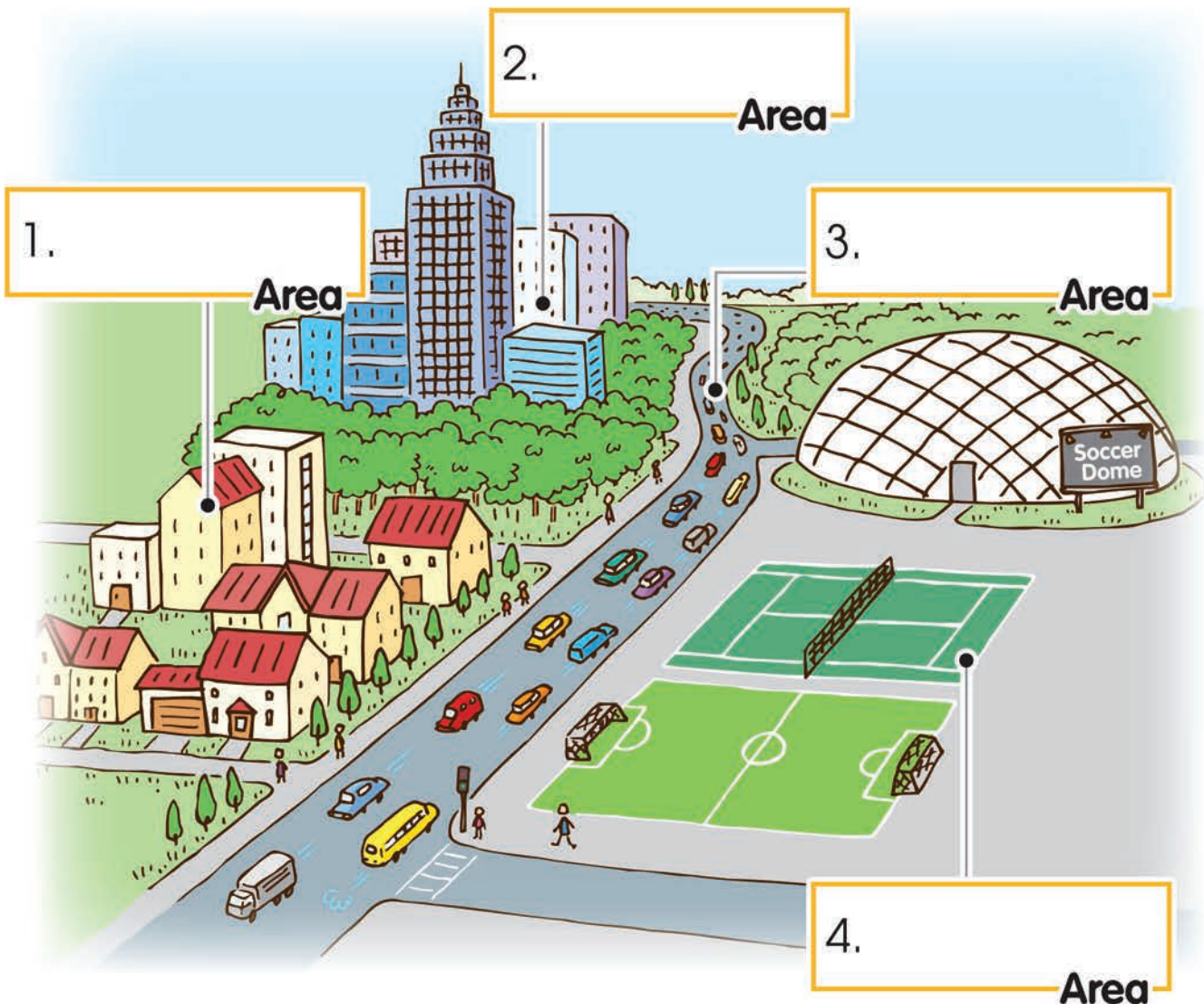

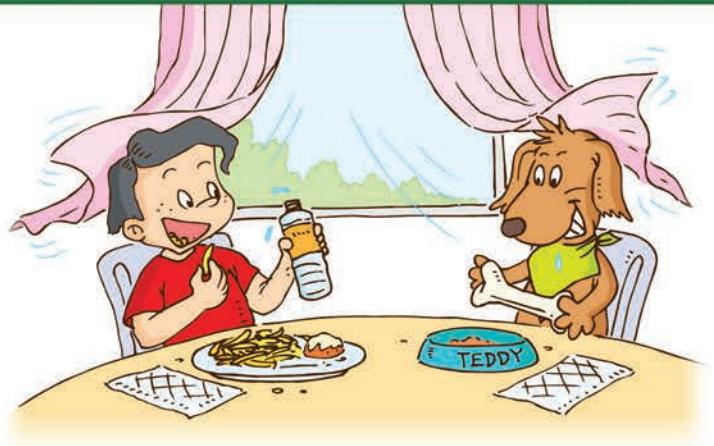
