1. INTRODUCTION

The Aspire Mobile Shower Commode range is designed for a healthcare environment such as a facility or hospital. The commodes have a fabricated stainless steel frame and utilise plastic and PU components of various material specifications.

Clinical Applications and Area of Use

These commodes are appropriate for adult patient care and should only be used under the instruction of a carer or health professional.

Key Features

- Maximum Safe Working Load (SWL) of 200kg, 250kg & 400kg (dependent on model)
- Attendant propelled and self propelled options available
- Height adjustability to accommodate different users (TIS model only)
- Stainless steel finish
- Swing back safety arms for ease of cleaning and transfer
- Soft PU seat range in open or closed variations (sold separately)
- Easy slide weight bearing platform or swing away legrest options available
- Access trough with improved over toilet clearance for easy hygiene access
- 8º 18º backrest angle ensures patient comfort
- Angle adjustable backrest (swing away models only) for improved seating comfort
- Ultra low seat height of 590mm or down to 490mm when customised (swing away models only)



2. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

It is important that this User Manual is read in its entirety prior to using the commode. The manual is designed to ensure that users are equipped with the information required to competently and responsibly operate this commode.

It is recommended that the User Manual be kept in an easily accessible place for quick reference. If required, Aspire product specialists can provide additional training.

All warnings and cautions within this manual should be strictly adhered to. Failure to do so could result in harm to the patient or operator.

Warnings highlighted throughout this manual identify possible hazards in procedures or conditions which if not followed correctly could result in serious injury or fatality.

Cautions highlighted throughout this manual identify possible hazards in procedures or conditions, which if not followed correctly could result in equipment damage or failure.

GENERAL

- This commode is designed to be used indoors
- Suitable for wet areas but not pools
- The clinically qualified person responsible should consider the age, size and condition of the patient before using the commode
- The maximum user weight is 200kg, 250kg or 400kg (dependent on model)

- ALWAYS check with your healthcare professional prior to using this commode.
- **ALWAYS** apply the brakes when the commode is stationary.
- ALWAYS ensure brakes remain locked when transferring into or out of the commode.
- ALWAYS ensure that the legrests are swung away when transferring into and out
 of the commode.
- ALWAYS ensure that attendant and patient limbs are free from potential entrapment areas before operating any functions.
- **DO NOT** stand on the product.
- DO NOT use outdoors.
- **DO NOT** use this product without reading the user manual in its entirety.
- DO NOT use if defective.
- DO NOT make any changes or modifications to this product without consultation from your Aspire Dealer.

The Aspire Mobile Shower Commode range is designed specifically for the Aged Care and Hospital environments. Please take time to familiarise yourself with key components shown below:





5. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

SWING AWAY LEGREST MODELS

Step 1

Remove commode from box & clear away all packaging materials.



Step 3

Attach legrests into lugs mounted on commode frame **1** & tighten with screws underneath top lug **2**



Step 2

Detach screws that are fitted into backrest, swing arms and backrest into position and secure in place with screws.



Step 4

Using seat mounting hardware, affix the seat 3 (sold seperately) to the top of the frame and screw in place until tight 4





Step 5

Slide in pan carrier & bowl (sold separately).



WEIGHT BEARING PLATFORM MODELS

Step 1

Remove commode from box & clear away all packaging materials.



Step 3

Using seat mounting hardware, affix the seat 1 (sold seperately) to the top of the frame and screw in place until tight 2





Step 2

Detach screws that are fitted into backrest, swing arms and backrest into position and secure in place with screws.



Step 4

Slide in pan carrier & bowl (sold separately).



TILT & RECLINE MODELS

Step 1

Remove commode from box & clear away all packaging materials.



Step 3

Attach legrests into lugs mounted on commode frame 3 & tighten with screws underneath top lug 4



Step 5

Slide in pan carrier & bowl (sold separately).



Step 2

Raise backrest into desired position 1, it will click into place when secure. Slide in top frame and secure with C Clips 2





Step 4

Using seat mounting hardware, affix the seat **5** (sold seperately) to the top of the frame and screw in place until tight **6**





SELF PROPELLING MODELS

Step 1

Remove commode from box & clear away all packaging materials.



Step 3

Attach legrests into lugs mounted on commode frame 1 & tighten with screws underneath top lug 2 (swing away legrest models only).



Step 5

Slide in pan carrier & bowl (sold separately).



Step 2

Detach screws that are fitted into backrest, swing arms and backrest into position and secure in place with screws.



Step 4

Using seat mounting hardware, affix the seat 3 (sold seperately) to the top of the frame and screw in place until tight. 4





Step 6

Remove locking pin from frame 5, insert through centre of wheel 6, mount brake with clamp onto each side of frame 7 detach rear castors and replace with antitippers. 8









6. OPERATION

Installing the Commode Seat (sold separately)

- Place seat onto top of frame and align along guides 1
- Using tri-wheel mounting kit (supplied with commode) screw the tri-wheels firmly into place until seat is secured onto the frame





Activating the Locking Castors - Attendant Propelled Models

- To engage, press the ON lever down with your foot
- To disengage, press the OFF lever down with your foot





Activating the Brakes - Self Propelled Models

- Push down and forward on the black hand levers on both sides of the commode to lock rear wheels in place 1
- Pull back on the hand lever to disengage brakes





Adjusting the Legrests (Swing Away Legrest Models Only)

- Lift and swing the legrests to desired position 1
- If the user wishes to vacate the chair, swing the footrests outwards for clearance. They can be completely removed by removing locking screw & lifting upwards





Backrest Angle Adjustment (All models except 600mm Weight Bearing and 450/530mm TIS)

- Backrest adjustment is facilitated by re positioning the offset washer, located on plate that connects the backrest to the seating support 1.
 There is 10° of angle adjustment available (8° or 18°).
- Using a 5mm Allen key and 10mm Shift lever, loosen two bolts 2 on either side of the commode.
- Rotate the offset washer on either side of the commode 3, adjust
 the backrest to the desired position, lock in place on either side of the
 commode.







Installing & Removing Pan Carrier & Commode Bowl/Pan (sold separately)

- Holding the handle of pan carrier, insert the front end into the mounting rails at the rear of the commode 1
- Place commode bowl or pan into pan carrier before sliding pan carrier underneath seat 2





Using Safety Armrests

 Swing armrests to desired position and ensure spring pin locks into place 1

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Fault	Cause	Solution
Difficulty in removing/ adjusting footrests	Build up of material in receivers	Remove footrests, clean receivers and footrest mounts
Difficulty adjusting the seat height	Build up of material in seat frame adjustment point	Remove upper from lower frame and clean thoroughly
Difficulty in maneuvering castors	Build up of dirt between fork and castor	Clean castors thoroughly
Difficulty in adjusting commode seat	Build up of material between frame and seat	Remove seat and clean thoroughly

9. CLEANING

WARNING

Note: It is strongly recommended that protective clothing be used when cleaning.

- Frame and metal components Always keep the commode clean for greater comfort and long-lasting performance. Clean stainless steel components with water and a mild detergent. Wipe dry.
- Brakes The braking effect depends on the state of the tyre tread. Excessive
 dirt build-up may negatively affect the application of the brakes. If necessary,
 clean tyres with a small brush to remove dust and waste.
- Seat and backrest padding Easy clean material that can be washed with water and neutral soap/detergent.
- Commode Bowl Remove and clean with water and a neutral soap/detergent.

CAUTION

Do not use abrasive Hypocarbonate or Phenolic compounds or pads.

10. SERVICE & MAINTENANCE

To prolong the working life of the commode and for trouble free operation it is recommended that routine inspections should be performed by a person who is suitably qualified and well acquainted with the design, use and care of Aspire Mobile Shower Commodes.

If inspection reveals that the safety of the commode is compromised in any way, it should be IMMEDIATELY WITHDRAWN FROM SERVICE, tagged as such and the owner notified, until repair or replacement has occurred.

Inspection:

A visual and functional inspection should be performed monthly and every time the commode changes user.

- Visually inspect mechanical components: Can you see damage, chips or deformation to the frame, armrests, seat, backrest, legrests or commode bowl?
- Are the castors, wheels and brakes functioning as they should?
- Are all frame securement hand wheels present and tightened?
