


ROYAL ASSCHER SIZE GUIDE

HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

Please carefully read all instructions as the measurement may not be accurate if not done properly.

- I. Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is set to "none" on your print dialog box.
- 2. Measure the bar on the right to ensure it is exactly 2 inches or 50mm long.
- 3. If measurement is not accurate, check that you are printing the page at full size (100%) and reprint before continuing.

Option 2: Create your own:


You will need a string or thin piece of paper, a pen or marker and a ruler.

- 1. Cut a piece of string or paper to at least 7.5cm or 3 inches long
- 2. Wrap it around the base of the finger you plan to wear your ring on. Make sure it is snug!
- 3. Using a pen, mark where the ends overlap.
- 4. Lay the string or piece of paper flat and use the ruler to measure the length in millimetres.
- 5. Use the ring size conversion chart to find your corresponding ring size.

Option 3: Measure finger with paper sizer

- 1. Carefully cut along the outline of the sizer. Make a small slit in the left end of the sizer.
- 2. Wrap the sizer around the intended finger with the numbers facing out.
- 3. Slide the pointed end of the sizer through the slit.
- 4. Move the sizer to the largest part of the finger, this may be the knuckle.
- 5. Pull tightly. The sizer must fit snugly to produce an accurate size.
- 6. The number that lines up at the slit represents the ring size for that finger.

Keep in mind that quarter and half sizes are available if your sizer indicates that your are in between sizes.



Notes for accurate measuring

- * Avoid measuring cold fingers as this is when fingers are at their smallest.
- * Measure your finger when it is at its largest, at the end of the day.



Option 4: Measure current ring

- I. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger. The "ring finger" is located between the little finger and the middle finger. Engagement and wedding rings are traditionally worn on the ring finger on the left hand in the United States and the UK.
- 2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size.
- 3. If the ring falls in between two sizes order the larger size.
