



Time for a refresh at Ragley for 2023, we were founded on a desire to do better in the hardtail market back in 2008 and with that we can't be caught sitting on our hands as things move on. It doesn't come lightly making changes to our line-up, we have a loyal fanbase we are very appreciative of but as the same time ensure we are still making the best performing frames that are keeping up and exceed riders demands. A few tweaks here and there have been made, progressive without being absurd, measured and considered and all in; frames that ride awesome but do not alienate.

Our MTB frame range is now more defined and clearer, allowing riders to hone into a frame that suits their preference and riding terrain.



## What is new?

- Our 27.5" Mmmbop and Blue Pig frames share a new more aggressive Enduro geometry.
- Our 29'' Big Al / Big Wig frames share a new more aggressive Enduro geometry.
- TRIG unchanged.

## What has changed with our MTB geometry?

In a nutshell – aim was to modernise our frames but not alienate our loyal customer base, sensible changes that make our frames more progressive but not unrealistically radical.

- Shorter Seat Tube Lengths
- Slacker Head Tube Angles
- Steeper Seat Tube Angles
- Longer Wheelbases
- Longer Headtubes
- Lower Bottom Brackets
- Frames now pedal better, fit better, and descend better.
- Better frame proportions regarding wheel size used.



## Geo changes from 2022 to 2023.

The Marley 29 is adopting a similar geometry to last year's Big Al for Trail use, the TRIG is unchanged and the Piglet, well we'll get to that. The following shows the updated Big Al, Big Wig, Blue Pig and Mmmbop geometries and the difference from the previous year geometry.
