# SAFETY

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- Do not operate any evaporative cooler with a damaged cord or plug.
- Read the evaporative cooler’s manual and labels thoroughly before use.
- Always unplug the evaporative cooler before performing maintenance or repairs.
- Do not stick your hands in the evaporative cooler while it is plugged in.
- Remove the plug from the electrical outlet by pulling on the plug, not the power cord.
- Operation near open flames or sparks is not recommended.
- When cleaning your evaporative cooler, ensure water does not get into the Fan Motor or electrical system to prevent damage.
- If the evaporative cooler is damaged or malfunctioning, do not operate it. Refer to the Limited Warranty or Troubleshooting sections of this manual.

## QUICK SET UP GUIDE

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1. Move the unit to the desired location before filling.  
**WARNING:** Moving the unit with a full Water Tank will cause damage to the product housing.
2. To fill the Water Tank, lift the Water Tank Fill Hatch located on top of the unit and pour **13.5 ounces** of water down into the Water Tank.  
**WARNING:** Do not overfill the Water Tank.
3. Using the USB cord (included with the fan) plug the unit into an electrical outlet.
4. Turn the unit on by the pressing the **ON/OFF** button on the Control Board Interface.
5. Set the speed to the desired level. Speed range: low and high.
6. Enjoy your ***Astro Kitty*** by Cool-A-Zone!

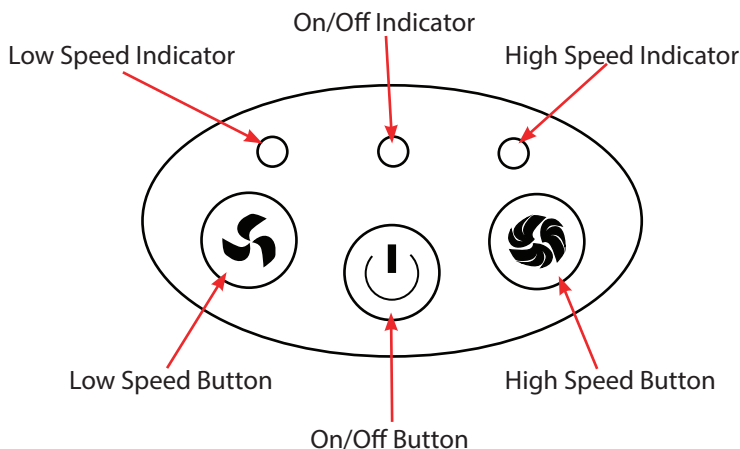
## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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1. Press the **ON/OFF** button one time to power on the unit. Press this button again to turn the unit off.
2. Press the **LOW SPEED** button to activate low speed.
3. Press the **HIGH SPEED** button to activate high speed.

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## ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

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Ensure that **BEFORE** doing any cleaning or maintenance, your Cool-A-Zone unit is powered **OFF** and **UNPLUGGED**!

1. **Exterior Cleaning:** We recommend cleaning exterior surfaces with soap and water (or a mild cleaner) and a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or alcohol-based chemical cleaning agents.
2. **Honeycomb Cooling Pad Cleaning:** We recommend removing the Honeycomb Cooling Pad and cleaning with a soft-bristled brush every two weeks (more frequently if the unit is operated in a dust-heavy environment).
  - To deep-clean your Honeycomb Cooling Pad, soak in a 50/50 solution of water and vinegar. You may use a soft-bristled brush to gently scrub excess residue and debris from the Honeycomb Cooling Pad. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning.
3. **Honeycomb Cooling Pad Drying:** The Honeycomb Cooling Pad should be dried if you are planning to store the unit.
4. **Honeycomb Cooling Pad Replacement:** The Honeycomb Cooling Pad should be replaced every 9 to 12 months, or more frequently depending on environment, use or water hardness.
5. **Water Tank Draining:** Drain water at the end of every use to increase longevity of the unit.
6. **Water Tank Cleaning:** We recommend cleaning the tank by hand bi-monthly. More frequent cleaning may be required for humid climates or dust-heavy environments.
7. **Unit Storage:** Prior to storing your unit, please ensure that you have cleaned and dried your Water Tank, Honeycomb Cooling Pad, and exterior housing. Store covered until needed again.
