

Use as directed on vinyl flooring, linoleum, terrazzo, concrete, and slate.


AcryliStrip ${ }^{\otimes}$ is a highly effective, fast acting floor finish stripper that will emulsify aged, burnished, and built-up finishes almost instantly. May be used as a no-scrub stripper or with a rotary floor machine and pad, depending on the concentration of the product and the condition of the floor.

## DIRECTIONS

1. Sweep or dust mop the floor to remove any debris.
2. Dilute stripper 1:4-1:10 with cold or mildly warm water. The optimum use-dilution will depend on the age and buildup of the floor finish.
3. Apply the stripping solution liberally using a mop or automatic scrubber Allow to stand for at least 3-5 minutes. Do not allow the stripper solution to dry. Be sure to completely cover floor to baseboards.
4. Scrub with a rotary floor machine or automatic scrubber equipped with stripping pads.
5. Pick-up the solution and old finish with a wet vacuum, automatic scrubber, or clean mop.
6. Rinse thoroughly with clean cold water.
