Shower Feed Carpet Brush



SF211M - 11" brush 13" machine
SF215M - 15" brush / 17" machine
SF218M - 18" brush / 20" machine

On brushes 14" in diameter and larger, the two outer rows are heavier to scrub the carpet and flex the pile while the softer inner rows "massage" the dirt from the carpet for a deeper cleaning action

- Carpeted areas
- No break-in process required

Soft Nylon Scrub Brush

Recommended use on

- Marble
- Terrazzo
- Highly polished floors
- Can withstand textured floors
- Resilient floors such as rubber and Luxury Vinyl Tile (LVT)
- Epoxy or non-slip floors
- Finished hard wood
- Will not scratch or dull
- Helps maintain clean and polished look

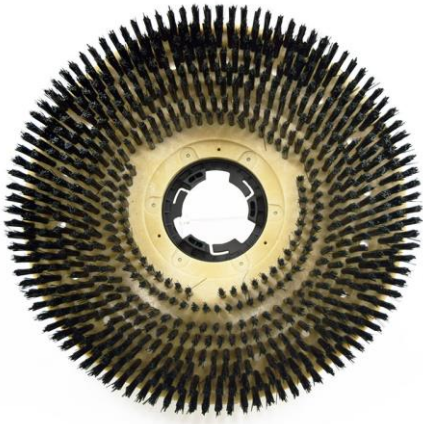

Recommended use on

- Vinyl
- Epoxy
- Linoleum
- Next step up in abrasiveness from soft brush
- Great for light to medium duty jobs
- For everyday generic cleaning
- Sealed concrete

Hard Poly Scrub Brush

For cleaning hard surfaces. Polypropylene scrubbing brushes feature .028" diameter fill material throughout the block. Polypropylene is an economical alternative to other fibers.

Recommended use on

- Tile / Grouted Floors
- Can also be used for general purpose cleaning
- Porous Hard Floors
- Unfinished Concrete
- Will remove a shine over time

Recommended use on

- WILL REMOVE A SHINE, DO NOT USE ON SEALED / FINISHED FLOORS
- Tile / Grouted Floors
- Porous Hard Floors
- Light Stripping
- Great for aggressive cleaning
- Carbon Impregnated bristles
- Heavy buildup / stains on concrete
- Unfinished Concrete

Quick Tips

- Nylon is more flexible, and will hold its shape longer
- Poly is usually more economical (cheaper)
- Even if bristles are the same "fill size" the Poly bristle will be slightly stiffer than a nylon bristle
- Rule of thumb, we use a brush that is 2" smaller so that the brush will fit inside the hub of the floor machine
- Never use a Grit brush on a floor that has any shine to it
- Brushes outlast pads at least 150 to 1
