

# DayMark Gateway/Menu Pilot Installation Instructions

Please note this installation process will vary by tablet brand and Android version. Also note it may not work on your Android Device. Our Applications require Android Version 4.4.4 or higher. Screen appearances may also differ by the tablet's manufacturer.

To check your Tablets Android Version go into your tablet settings and find About Tablet, this will tell you what Android version you are currently running. Then go to the Table of Contents on page 2 to jump to the page regarding your Android Version.

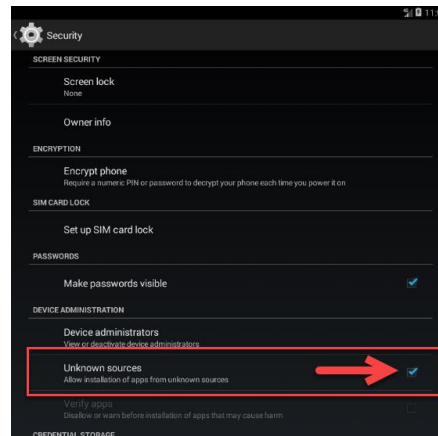
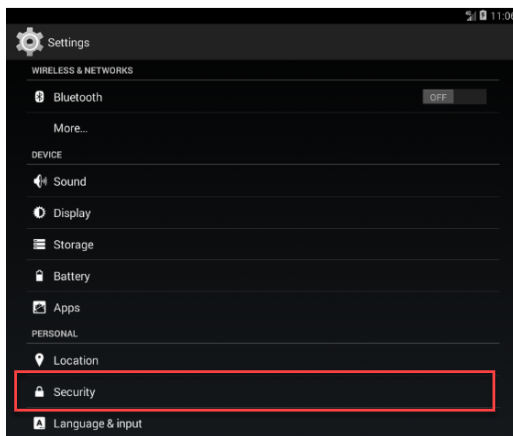

## Installation on Android 4.4.4

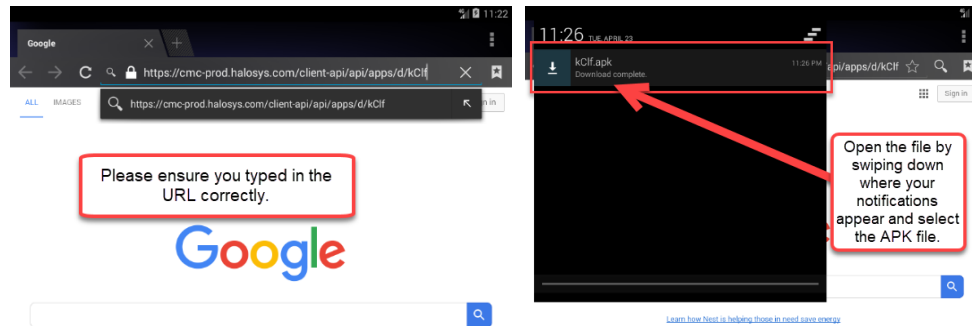
1. Make sure you are connected to WiFi in your tablets settings before starting.
2. Go into your Tablet's Settings, the select Security and check or toggle on Unknown Sources. When turning this on your tablet may warn you press okay or allow to continue.



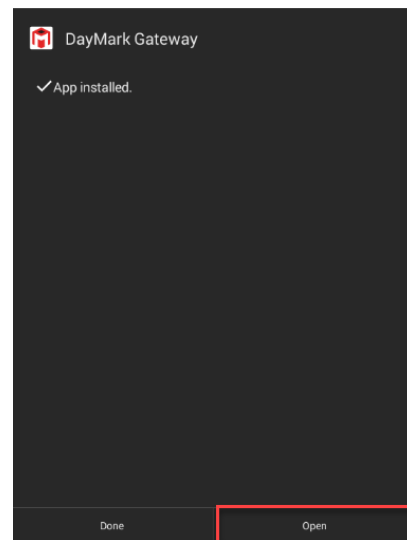
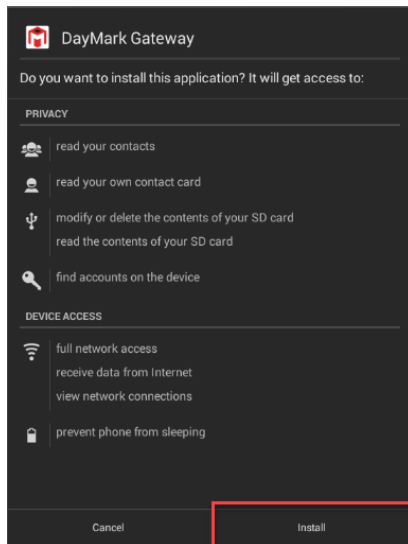

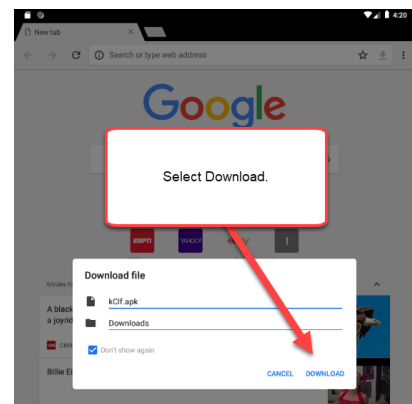
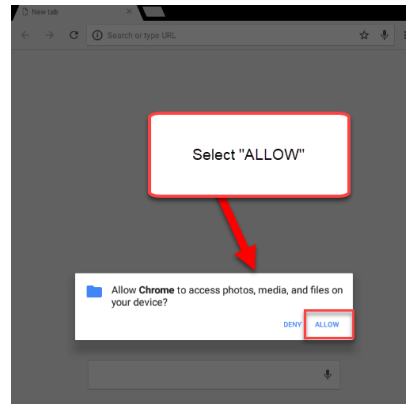
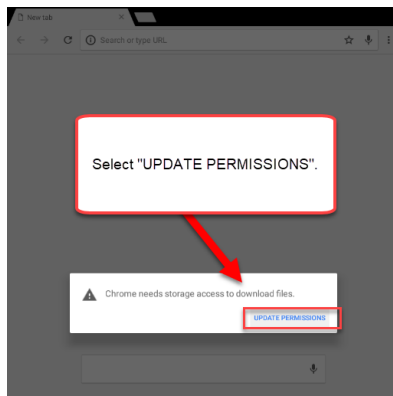
1. Make sure you are connected to WiFi in your tablets settings before starting.

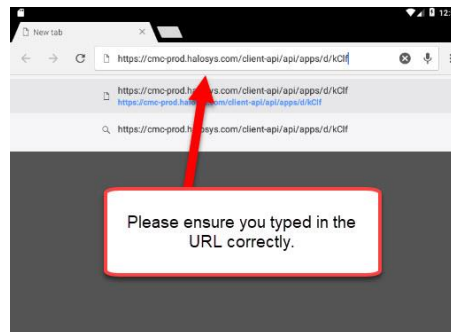


## Installation on Android 9.0 PIE

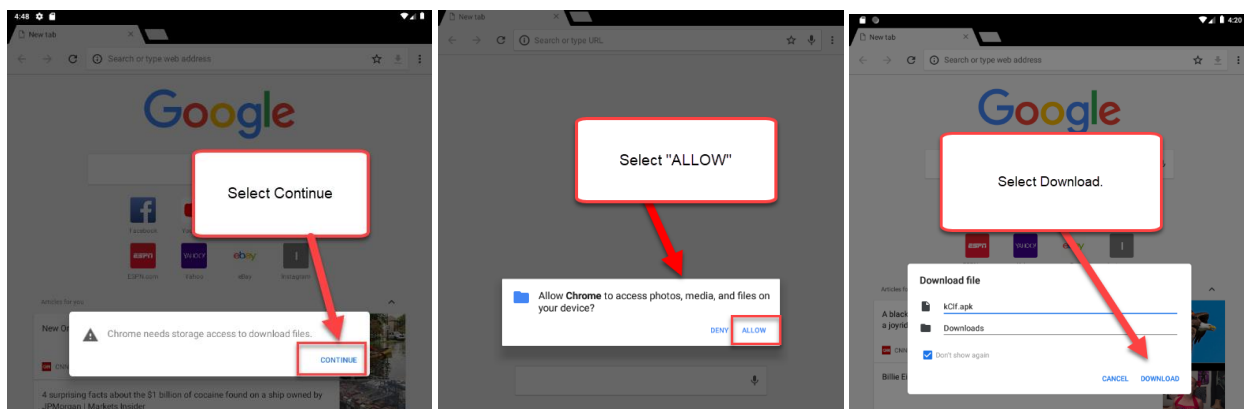
1. Make sure you are connected to WiFi in your tablets settings before starting.
