
WRAPPED YARN ORNAMENTS




Step by step instructions:

- 1. Place the cookie cutter on top of the Styrofoam.
- 2. Using a pen, mark the outline of the star on the Styrofoam.



mark out the outline (about 0.3" apart). Don't stick them all the way in.

White glue

Sewing pins

Fishing string

Pen


Yarn

- Scissors
- Plastic fork



- **4.** Pour some white glue into a small bowl.
- **5.** Soak the yarn in the bowl with the glue but hold one end outside.
- **6.** Slide the yarn through the fork prongs, then pull it up and through to remove excess glue.






8. Once you feel your shape is ready, tuck the end of the yarn (so it won't be seen).





- **9.** Use your finger to gently push the yarn down on each of the pins. And also make sure all the layers of the yarn are touching each other so they stick together well once the glue dries.
- **10.** Pour some glitter powder on top.



12. The pins are going to be glued to the yarn, so you have to loosen the grip in a gentle circular movement to take them out. Once the dry glue breaks, use your fingernail to hold the yarn down as you pull out each of the pins from the Styrofoam.

13. Once all the pins have been removed, use a flat knife to separate the ornament from the Styrofoam.

14. Tie the star on the fishing string and hang it on your Christmas tree.
