

With a medium intense black cherry colour and youthful purple edge, this popular Pinotage captivates with concentrated and supple aromas of sweet brambleberry and mulberry, with hints of sweet spice. This medium-bodied, well-balanced wine boasts a fine tannin structure and lively acids, culminating in a lingering fruit finish. Enjoy this wine now, or mature for up to 5 years.

ON THE VINES

With an ideal Mediterranean microclimate, an abundance of soil diversity and water from the life-giving Breede River, the Alvi's Drift vineyards are ideally positioned for producing remarkable wines of unique character and complexity.

Our vineyards are sustainably fertilised with natural compost produced on our farm. Come harvest time, our grapes are carefully hand harvested from selected Pinotage vineyards in the cool, early morning hours to ensure optimal quality and flavour.

IN THE CELLAR

To produce this wine, hand-harvested grapes from selected Pinotage vineyards situated in the unique Scherpenheuvel wine ward are destemmed, crushed, cold soaked and then fermented on the skins for at least a week.

To add to the wine's complexity, at least 30% of this blend comes from our wild yeast-fermented Pinotage, aged in American oak barrels for up to 12 months and sourced from predominantly older vines. The rest of the Pinotage in this blend is fermented in stainless steel tanks, bringing a freshness and vibrancy to the wine.

HERITAGE

In 1928, the All Black rugby team, known as "the invincibles" was unassailable. They arrived on South African shores after completing an undefeated tour of France and the British colonies, expecting to continue their winning streak. The rugby world was rocked when a young unknown, 19-year old Albertus Viljoen van der Merwe, "Alvi" to his friends, scored the first try in history against the All Blacks on African soil.

Our charismatic founder gripped the rugby world's imagination by scoring this historic try, going on to be selected as the 221st player to play for the Springboks – South Africa's national rugby team. With Alvi in their ranks, the Springboks turned the tide on "the invincibles", going on to tour the UK and Europe undefeated.

Alvi's farm in Worcester, South Africa,
has continued this winning legacy,
remaining family owned – and home to
three generations of the Van der Merwe
family – to this day. Today, the family farm
is home to the Alvi's Drift winery, known
for producing internationally acclaimed,
world-class wines of exceptional quality
and value.
