It has great aging potential and will benefit from up to eight years' maturation.

With an ideal Mediterranean microclimate, an abundance of soil diversity and water from the life-giving Breede River, the Alvi's Drift vineyards are ideally positioned for producing remarkable wines of unique character and complexity.

IN THE CELLAR

Optimally ripe grapes, hand-picked in the cool, early morning hours to preserve its crisp acidity are pressed, with preference given to free-run juice.

The exception to the other wines in our Reserve range, this wooded Chardonnay is 100% barrel fermented in French oak, lending a beautiful complexity to the finished wine.

HERITAGE


